Retired pathologist, Angus cattle breeder, arts patron, and renowned lecturer, Dr Richard Reed has had a much storied career in Melbourne.

His successful medical career includes roles in London and Australia – culminating in the position of Melbourne Pathology Chairman for 10 years – and as an author of leading articles for medical journals. Dr Reed has also played an integral role in one of the most meaningful clinical trials in the world. Known as the International Breast Cancer Study, based in Bern, Switzerland, it is a model for other cancer trials, globally.

He oversees a 200-hectare farm, raising registered Angus cattle with the prefix All Black, and is also a respected member of the arts community in Australia, having headed the Board of the NGV (National Gallery of Victoria) Foundation.
