# Introduction

## Objective

MMG Education (MMG) was commissioned by the Executive Principal of Christ's College to provide deep insights and research-based information relating to stakeholders' views and expectations in order to assist in driving continual improvement in the quality of education provided to the parents.

This report presents MMG's findings relating to the view of **Year 13 parents and students** and is based on a tailored in-depth survey administered in web based, online format.

## Response Rates

**52%** of parents completed questionnaires (n=64)

**86%** of students completed questionnaires (n=109)

## Definitions & Explanations

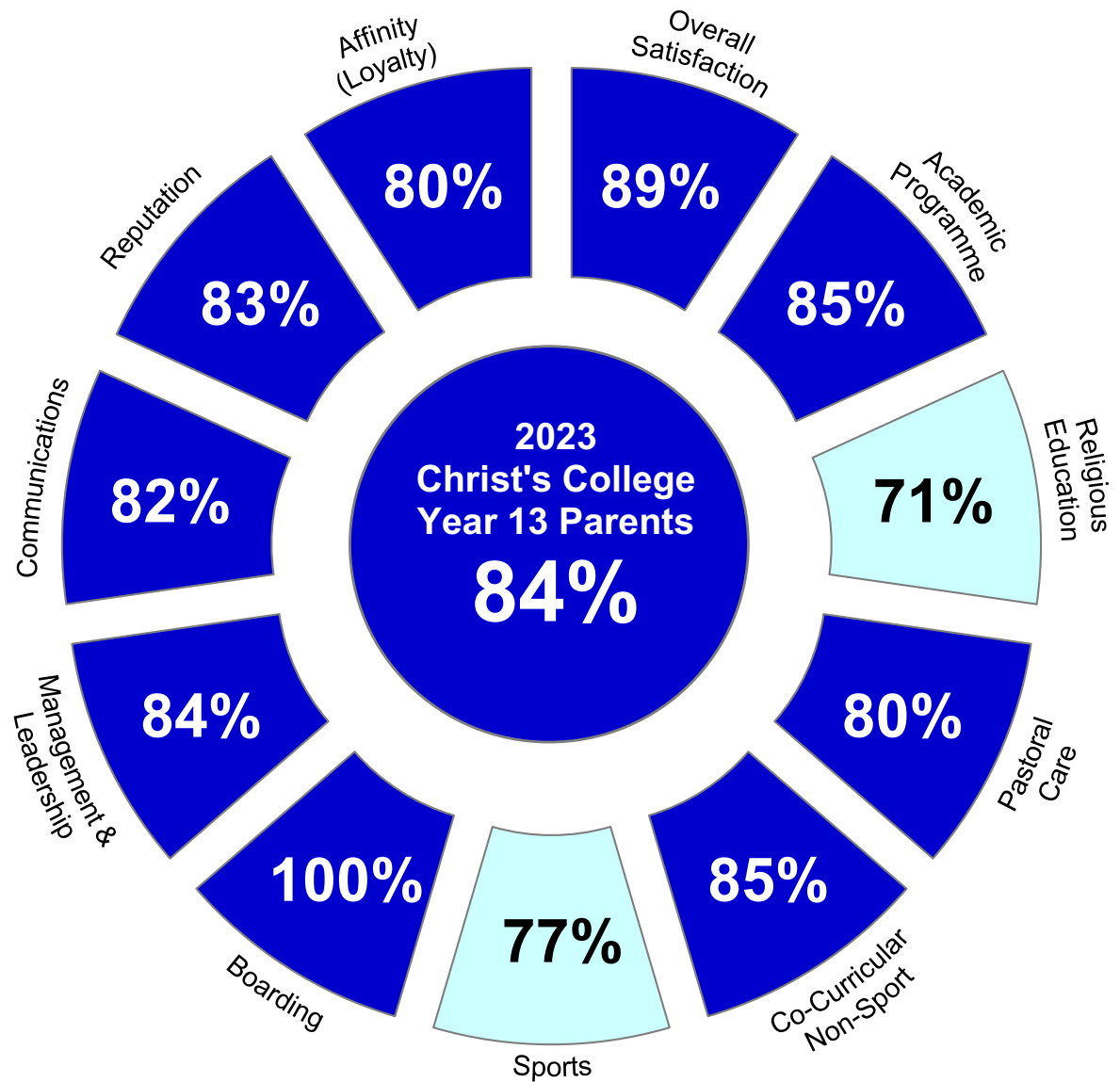
1. Percentage scores have been provided on all key areas with both a distribution of findings and overall mean in order to gain a full appreciation of results
2. Top performing schools are achieving 80% in key areas. Scores of 80% and above are indicators of strong performance which translates to high advocacy and school of first choice status
3. Top box scores are the percentage scores rated as 'strongly agree' or 'very satisfied'. These classifications are important indicators in a school's performance. As a general guide, schools need to pursue 30% or higher in the top box and <20% in the combined bottom two boxes
4. Scores reflect stakeholder perceptions of school performance. In cases where scores are lower than desirable, the school needs to identify whether these reflect reality and either initiate corrective action or correct such perceptions
5. MMG colour codes certain tables and charts based on level of performance

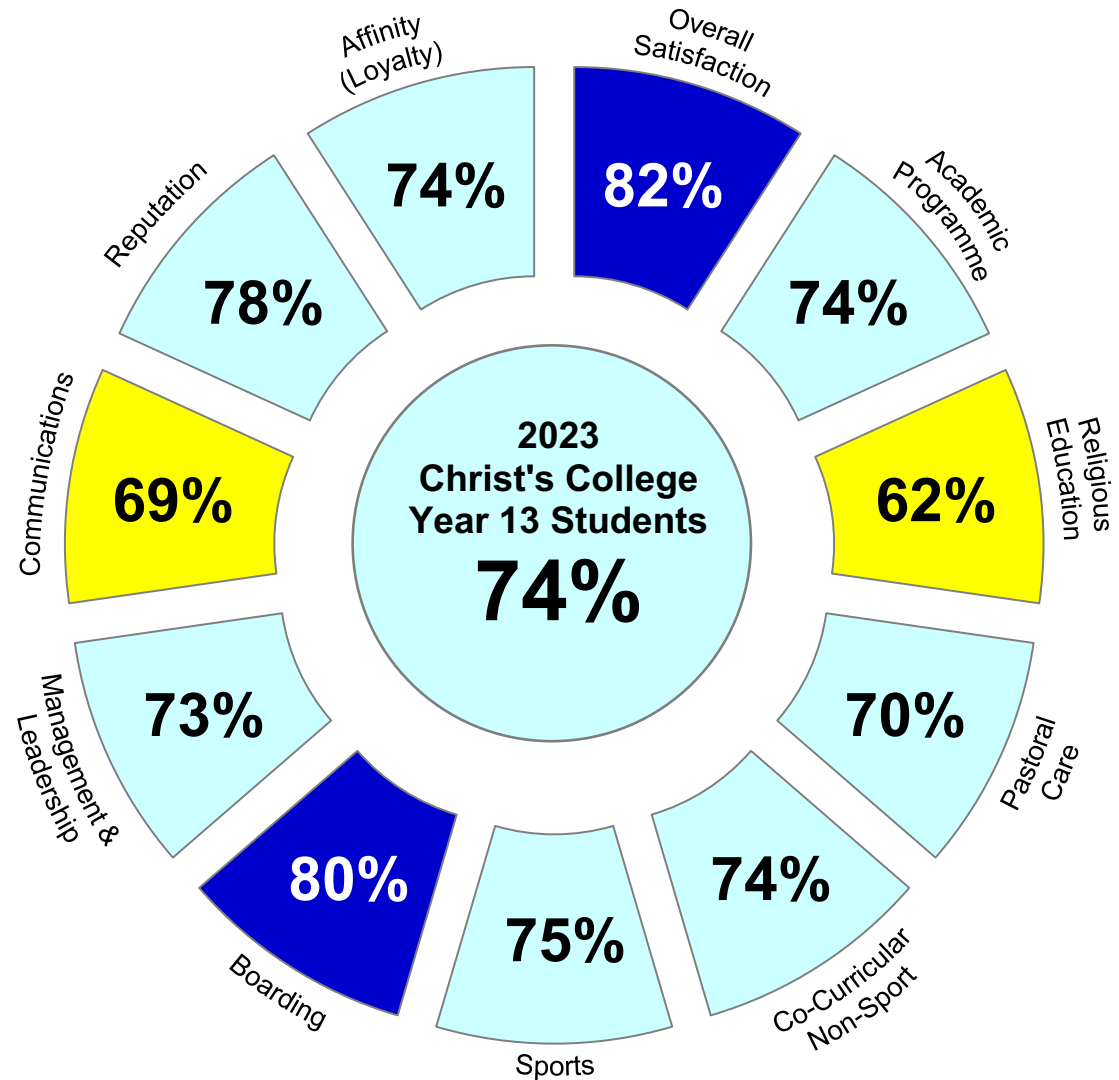

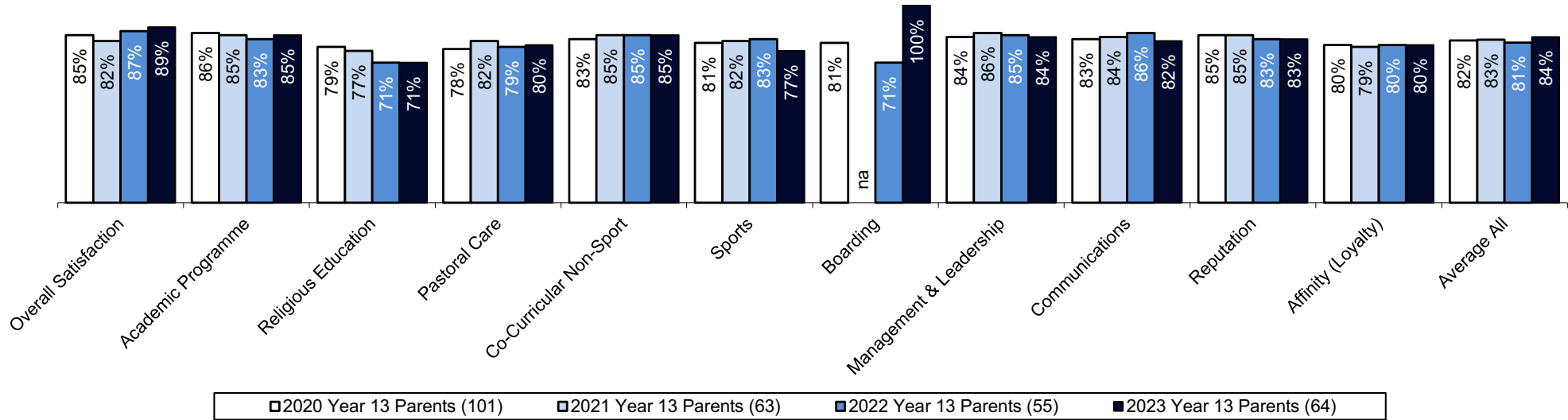

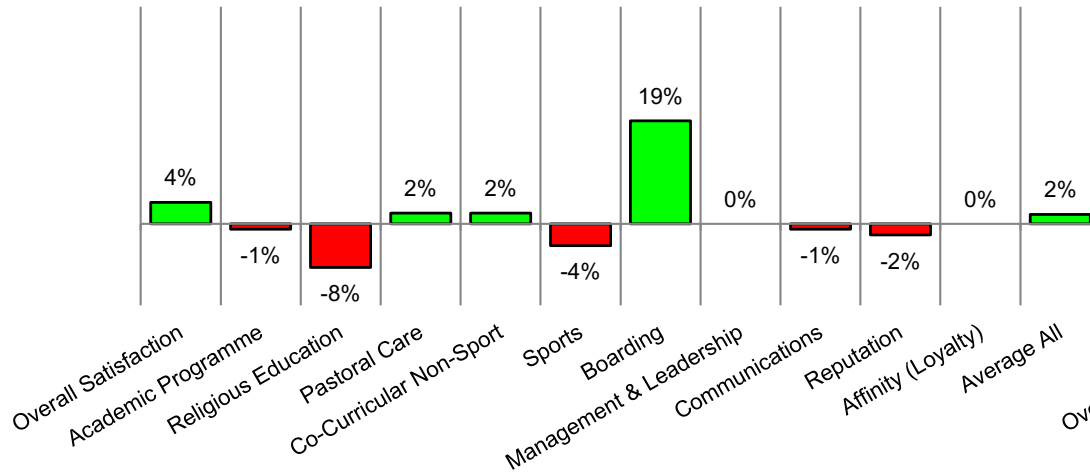

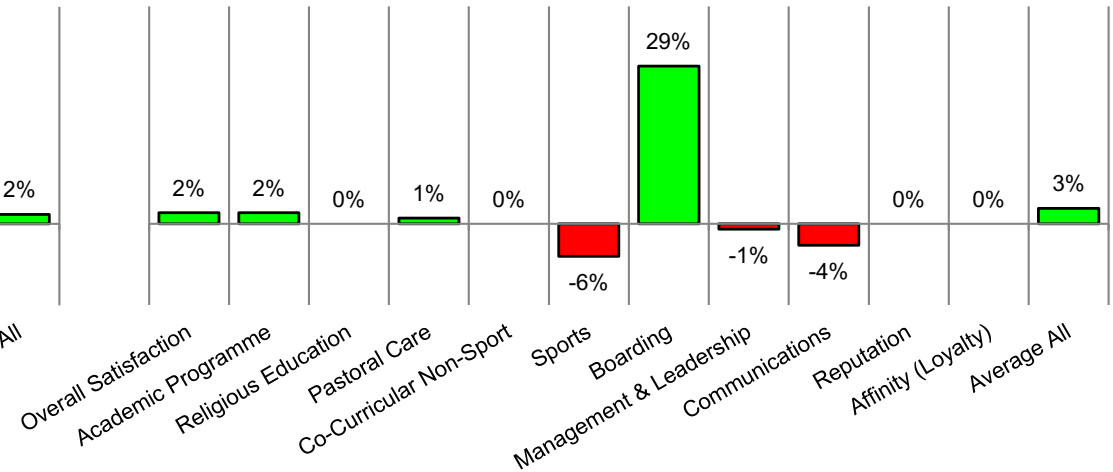
2023 Christ's College Year 13 Parents - Comparison of Key Areas to Previous Years

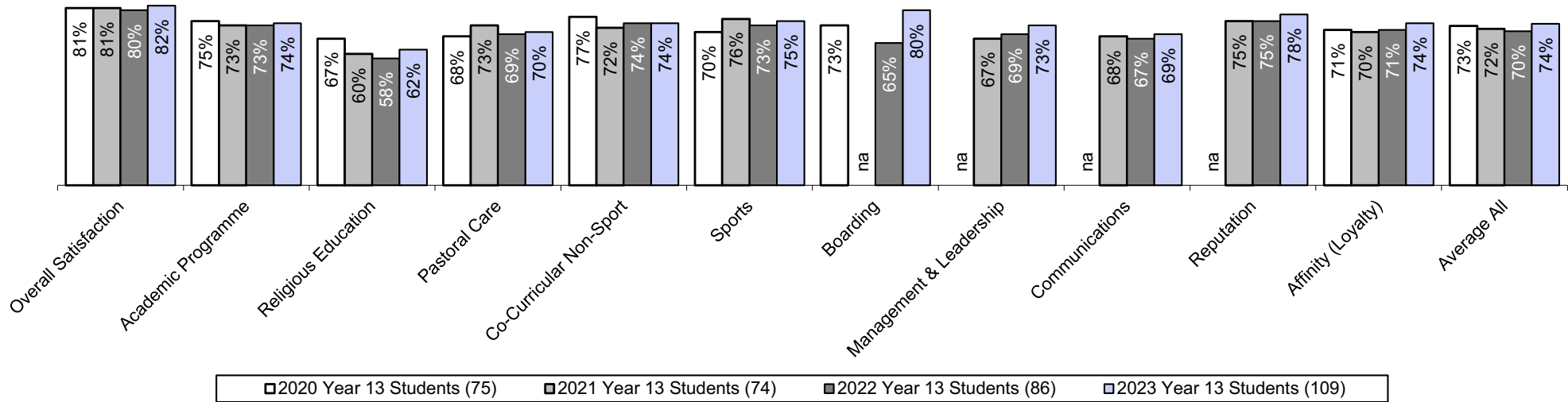

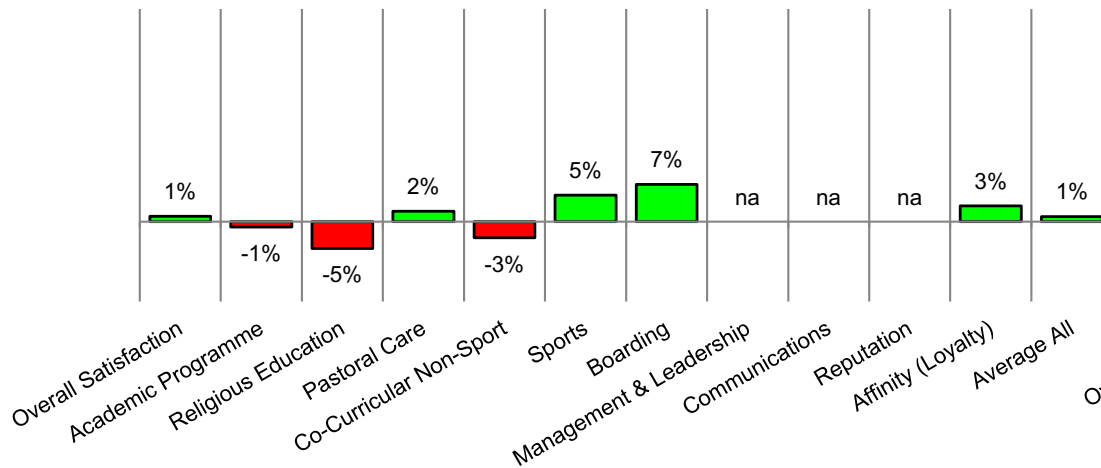

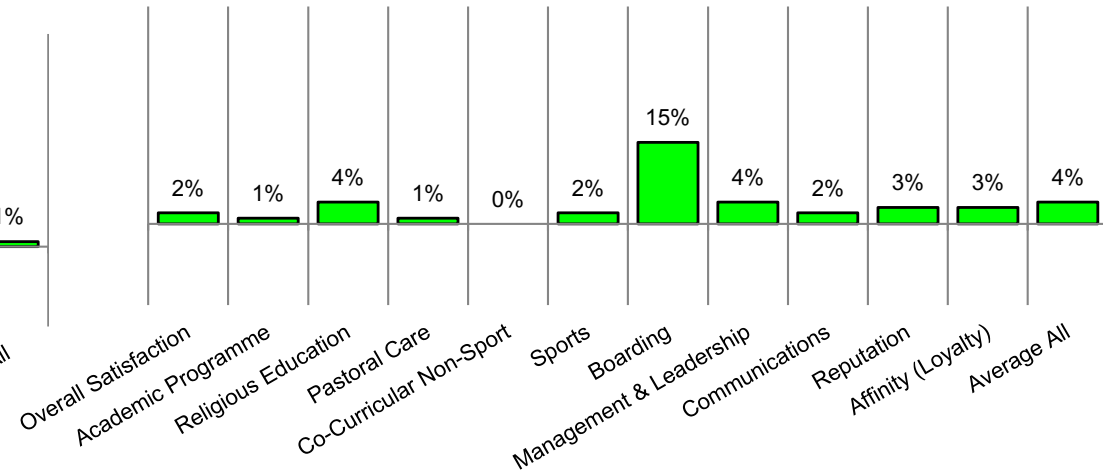
2023 Christ's College Year 13 Students - Comparison of Key Areas to Previous Years

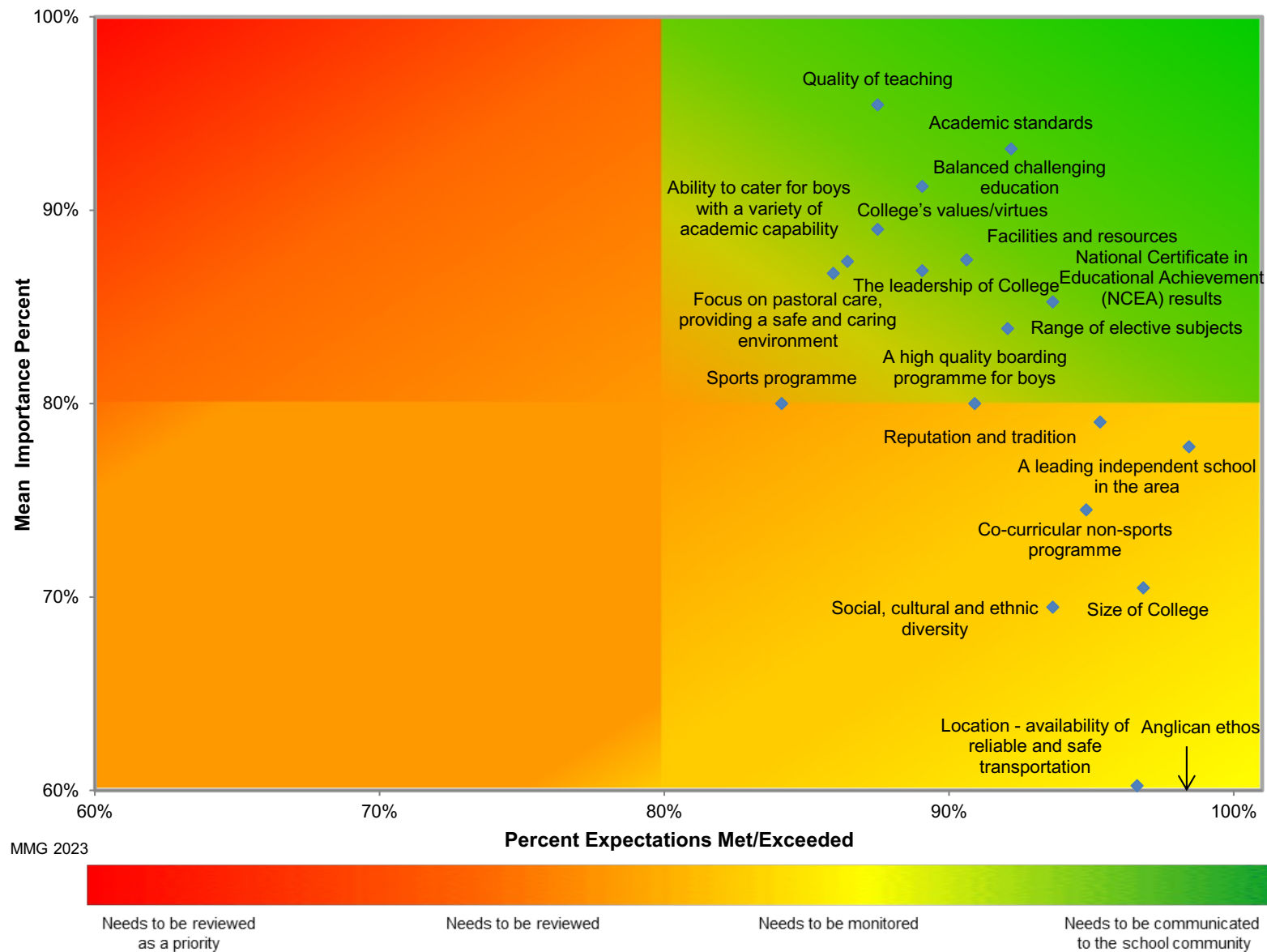

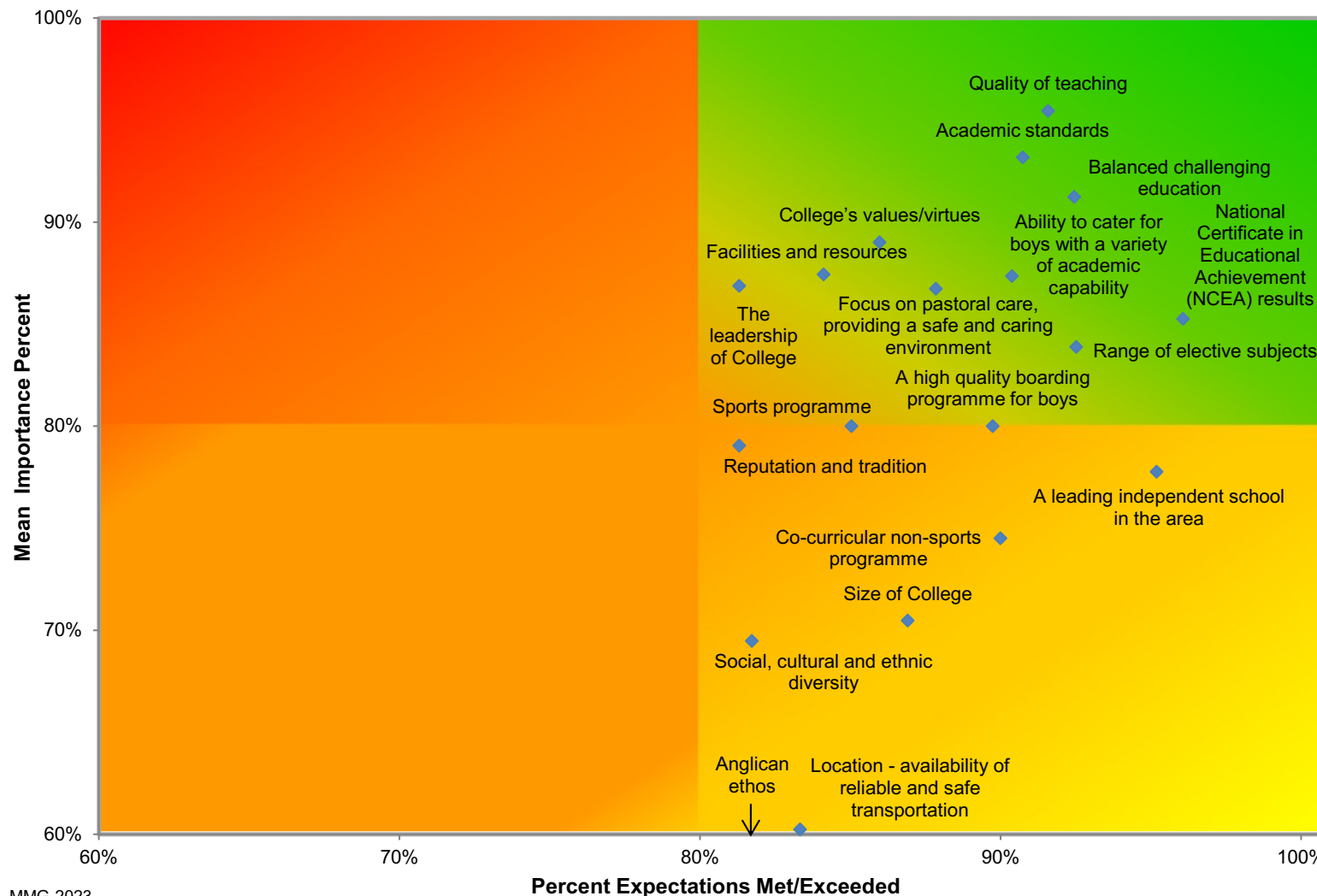

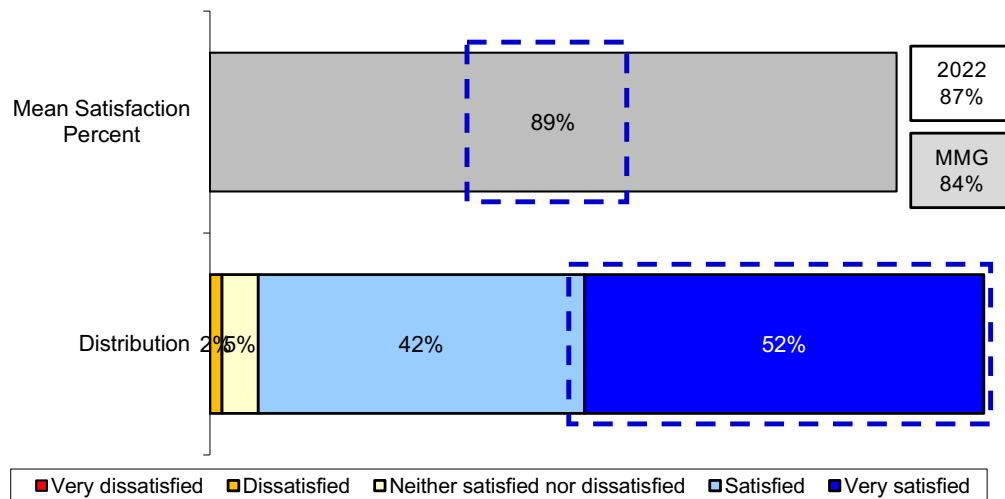

2023 Christ's College Year 13 Parents - Overall Satisfaction with Son's Education at Christ's College (n=64)



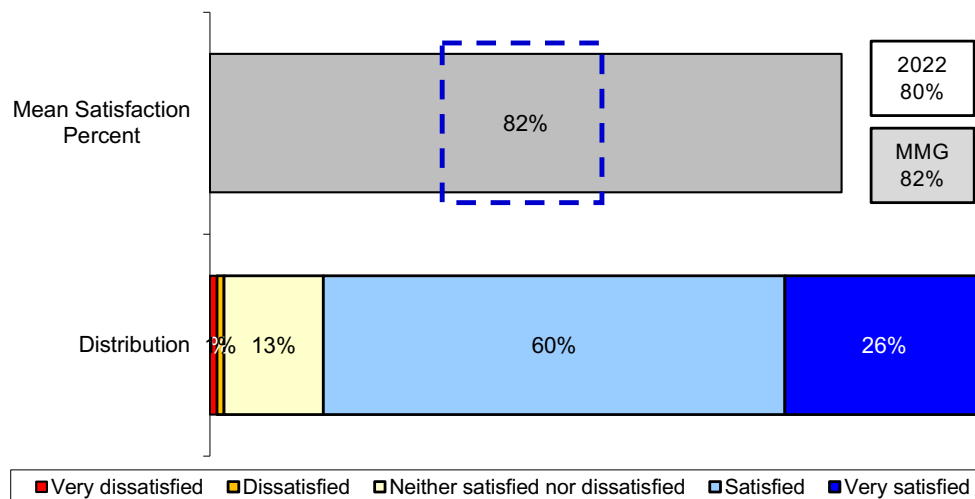

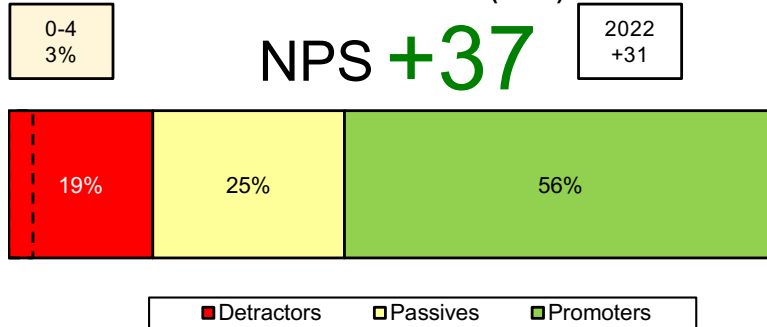

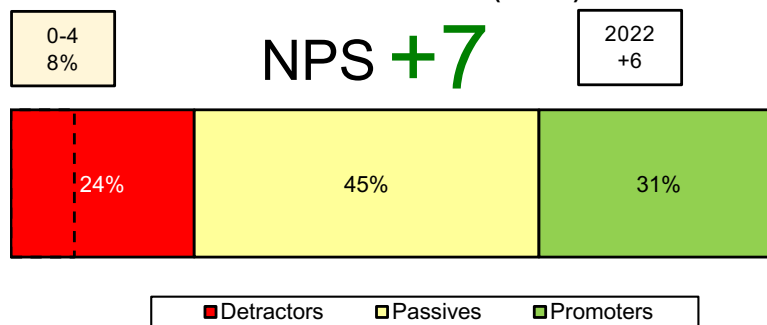

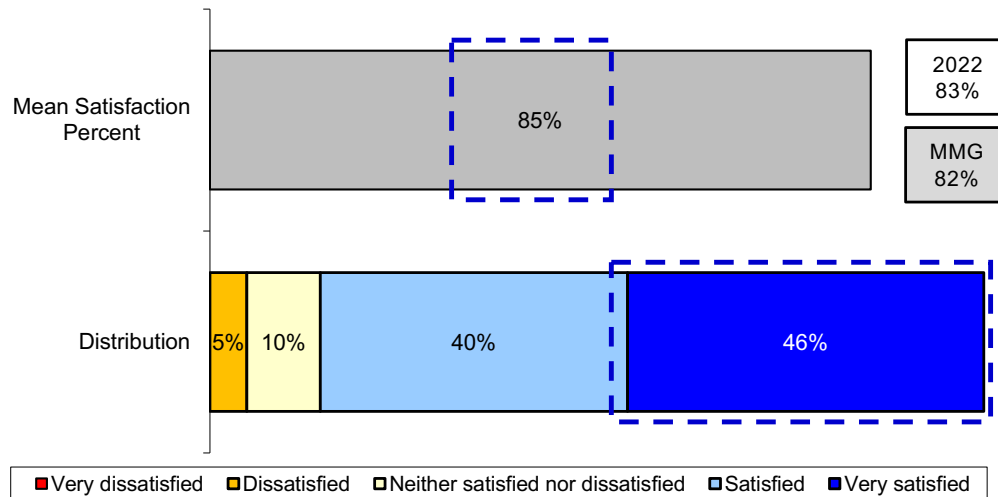

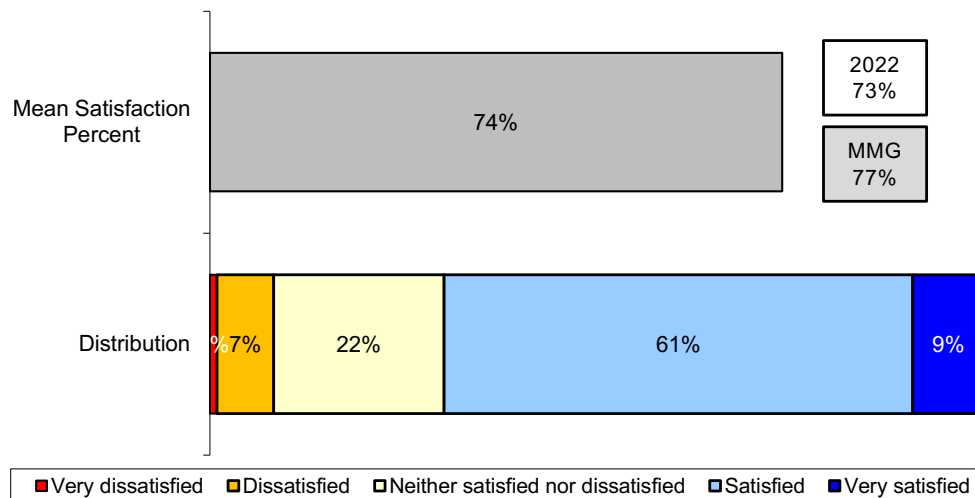

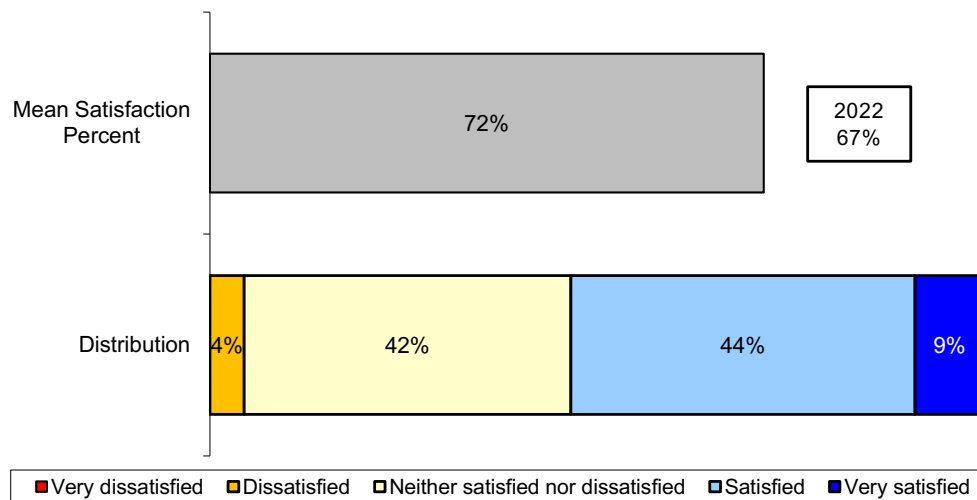

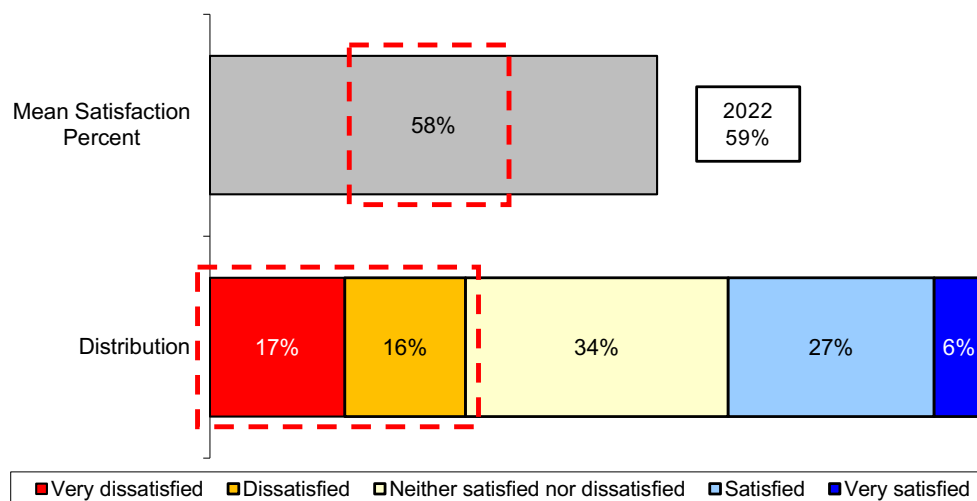

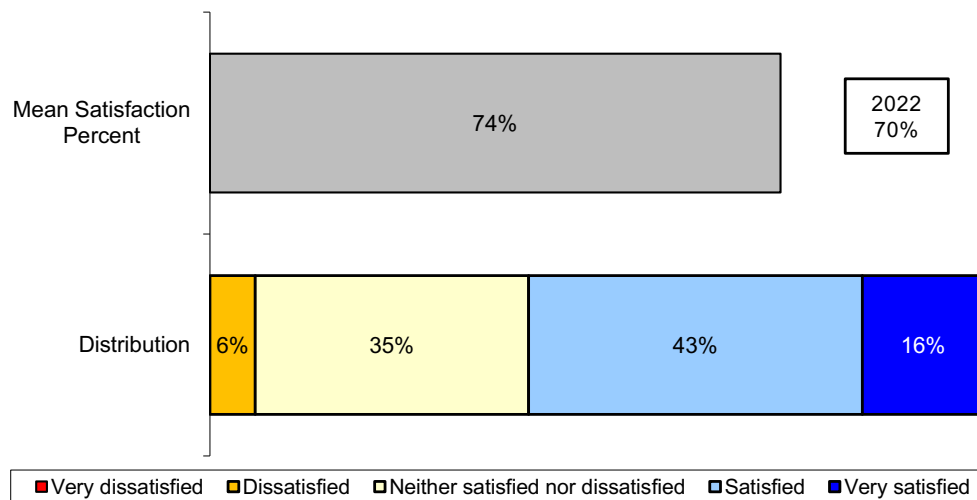

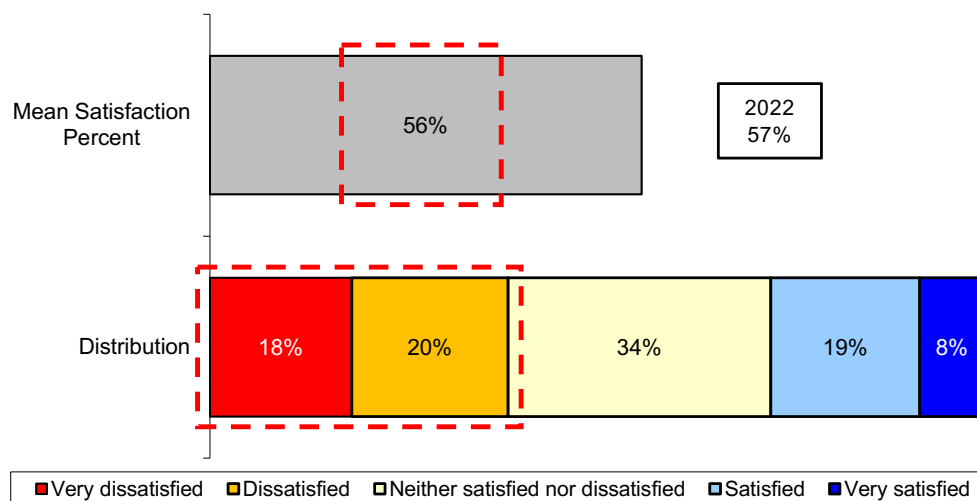

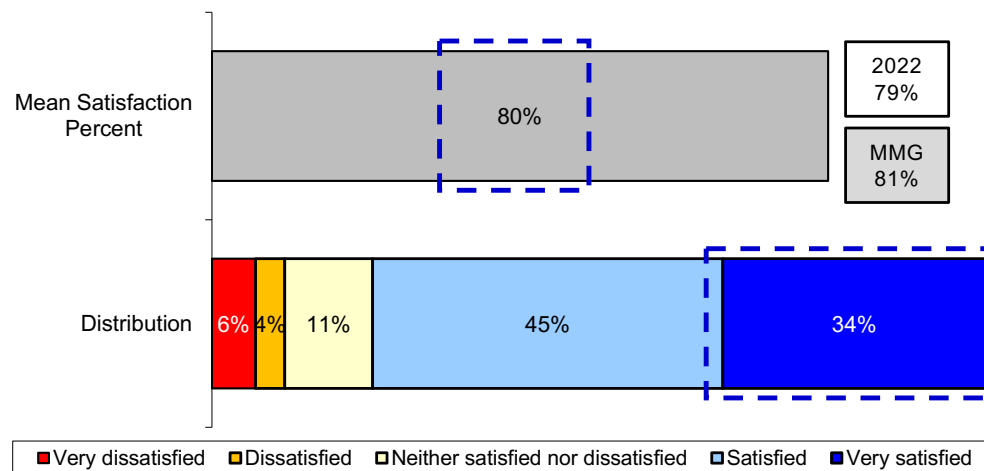

**2023 Christ's College Year 13 Parents - Overall Satisfaction with the Way the College has Met Your Son's Pastoral Care Needs (n=64)**



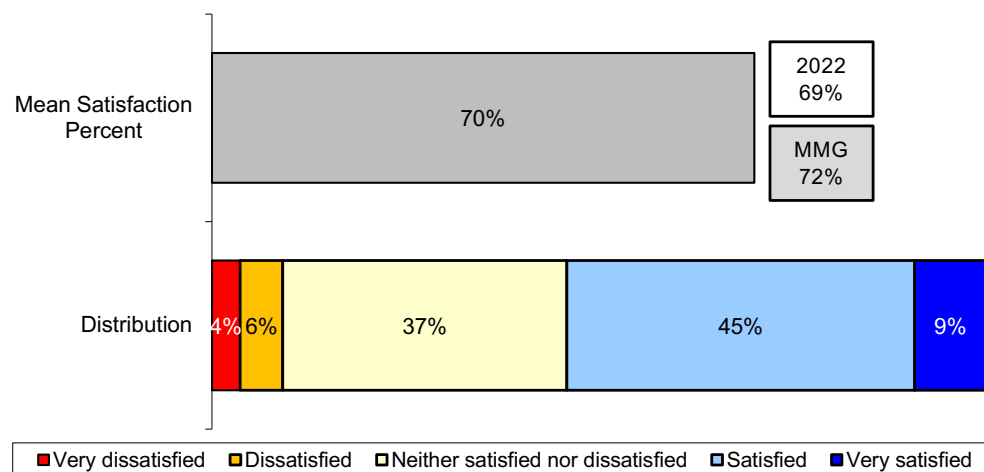

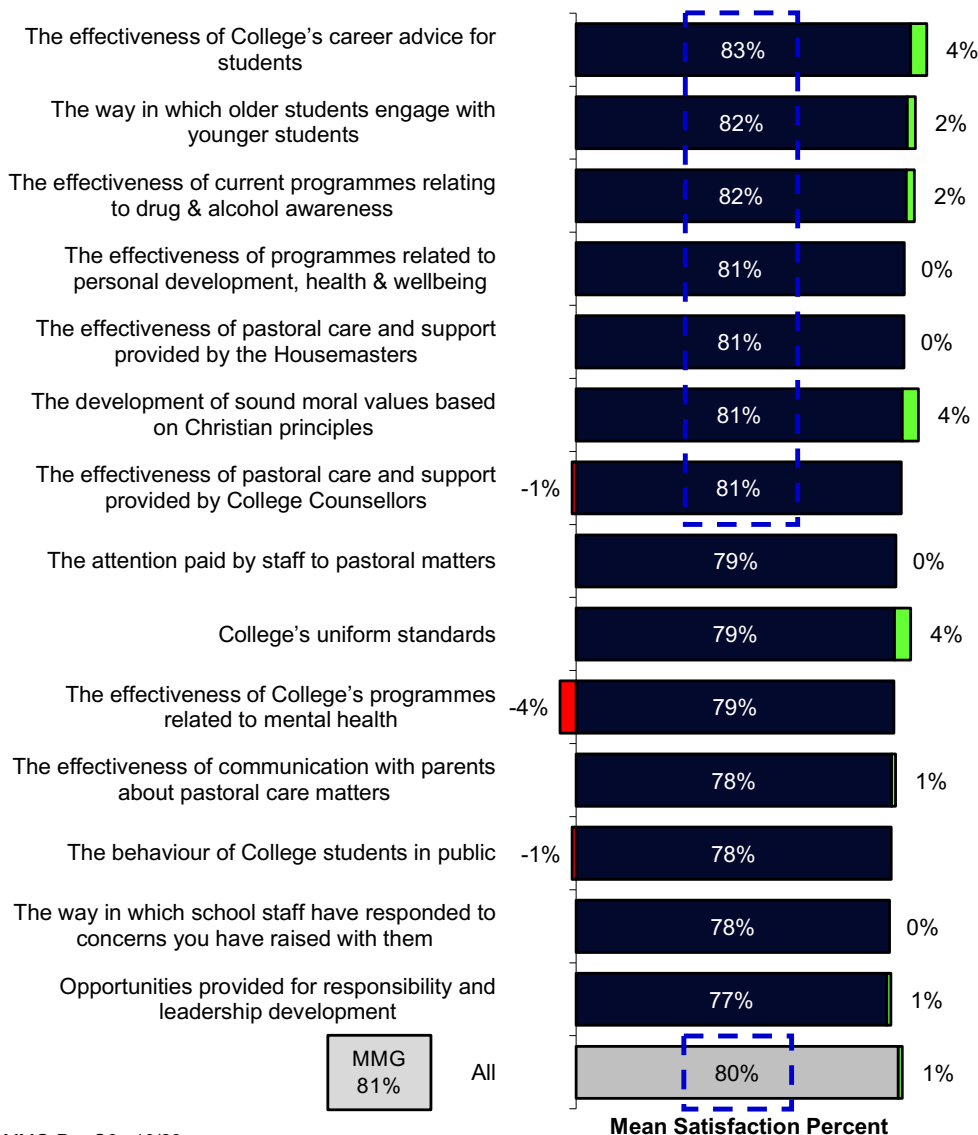

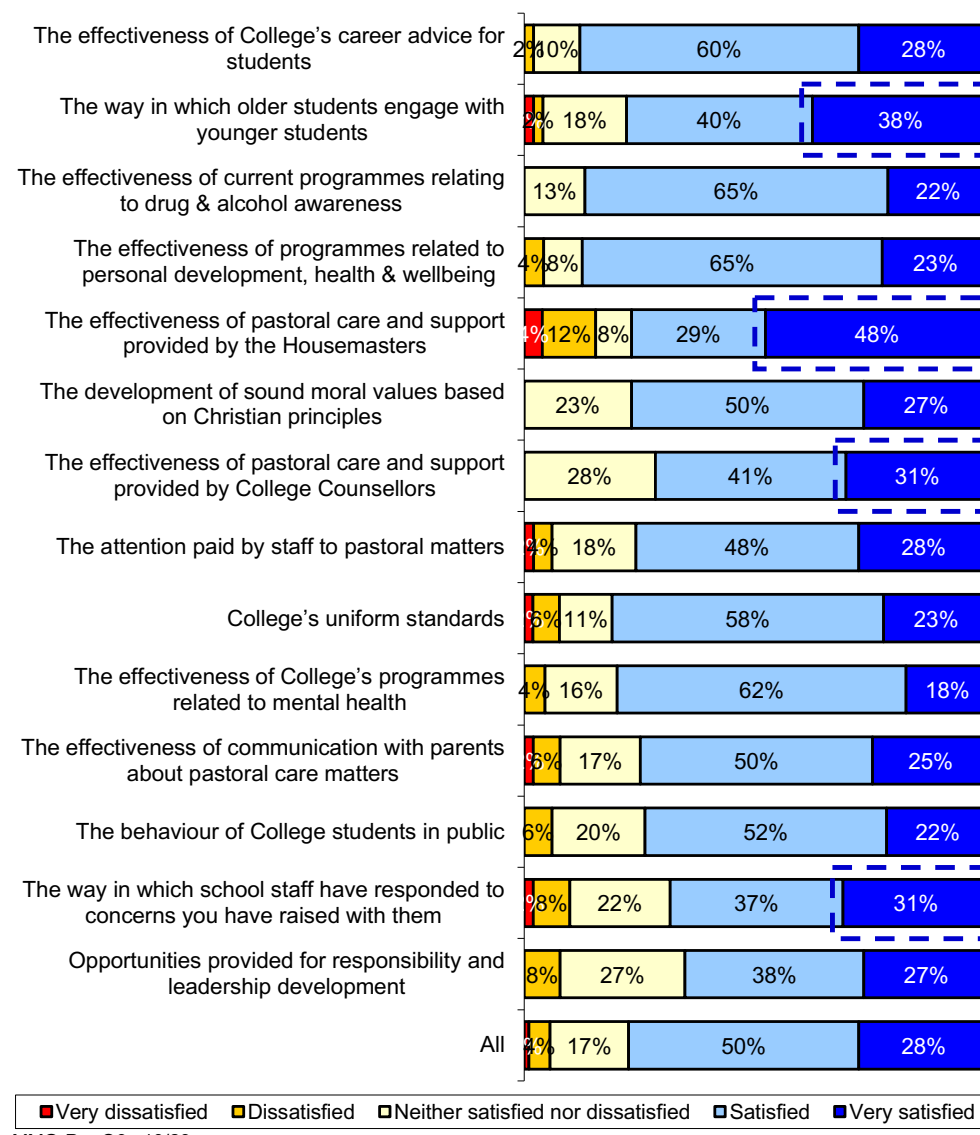

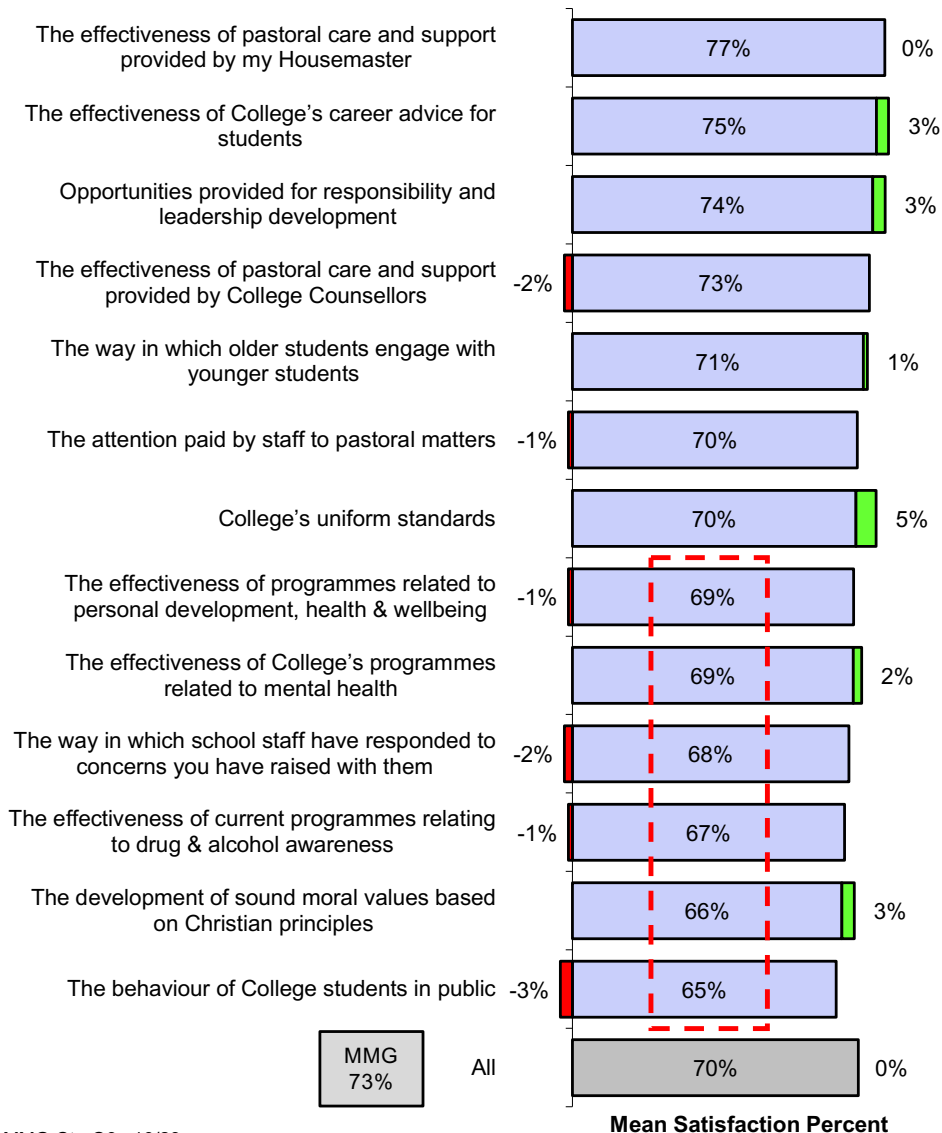

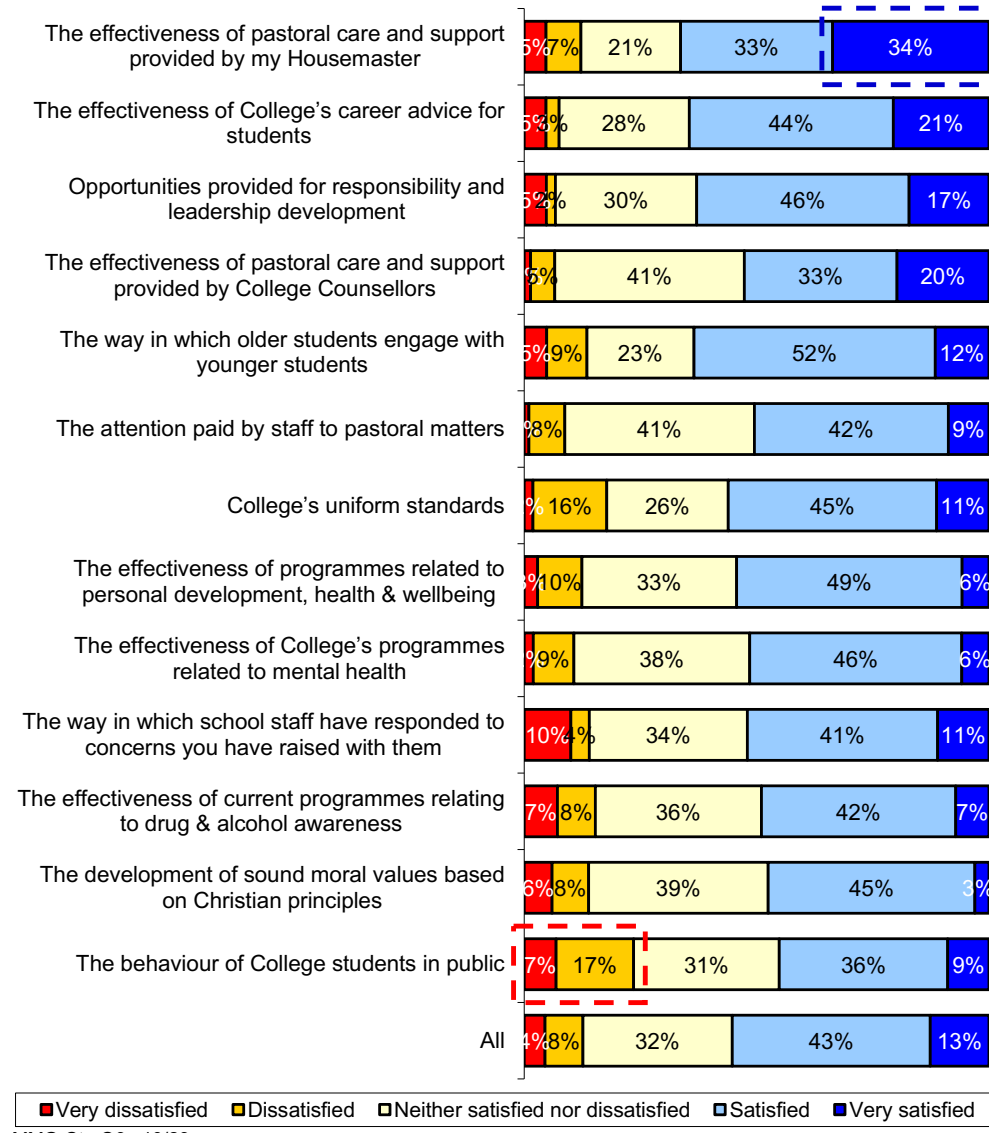

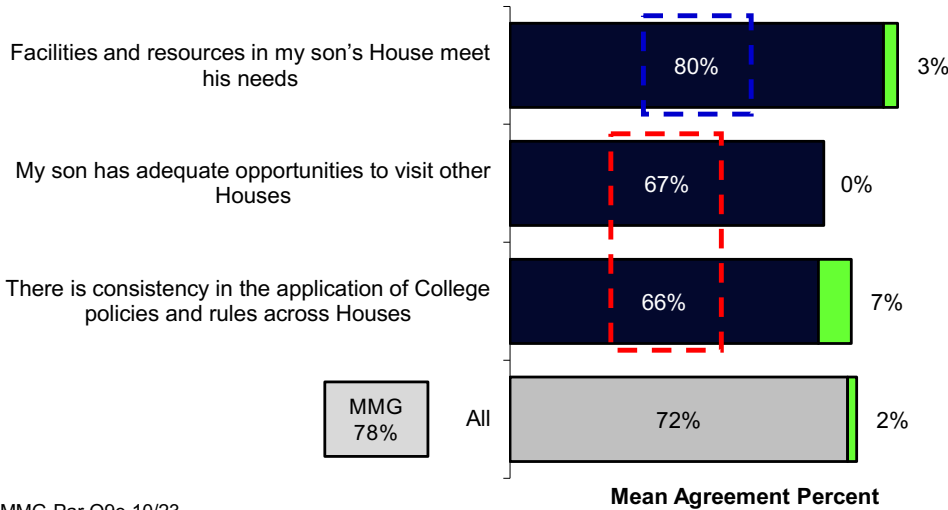

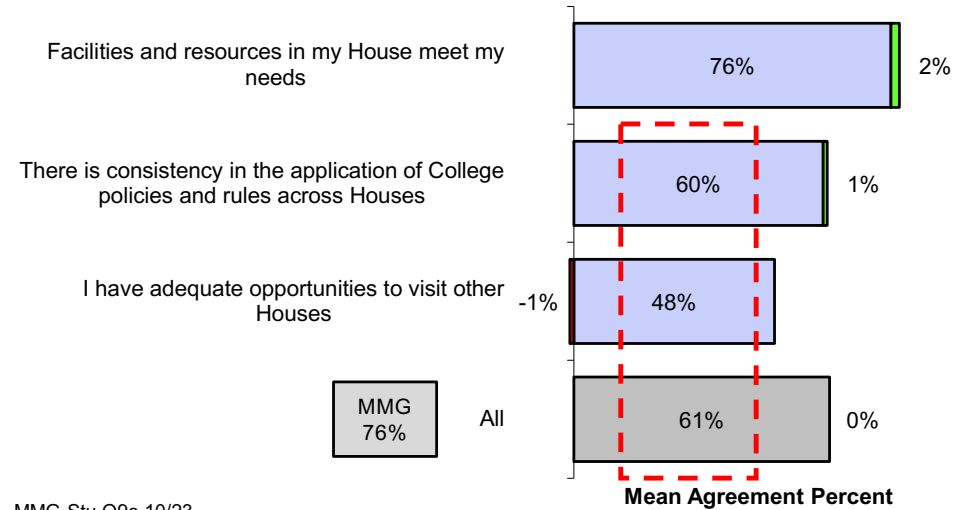

2023 Christ's College Year 13 Parents - Agreement with Statements Relating to College's House System (n=64)



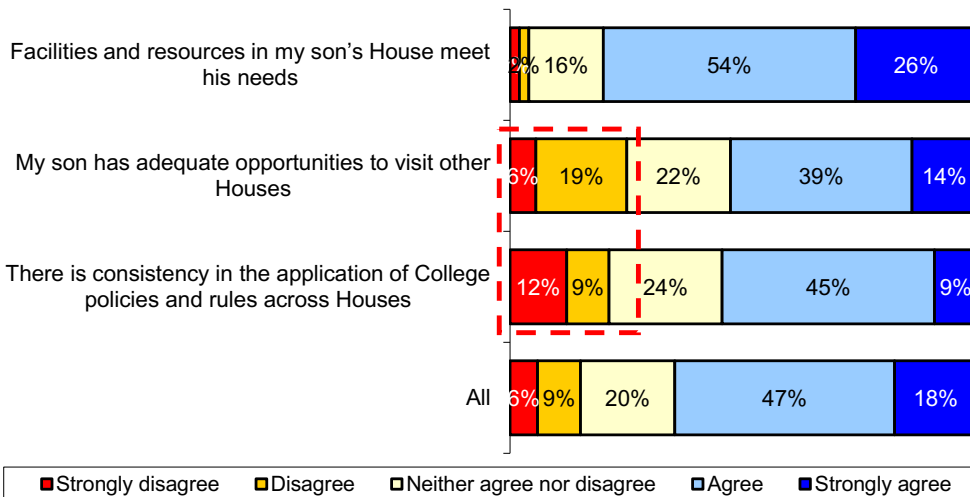

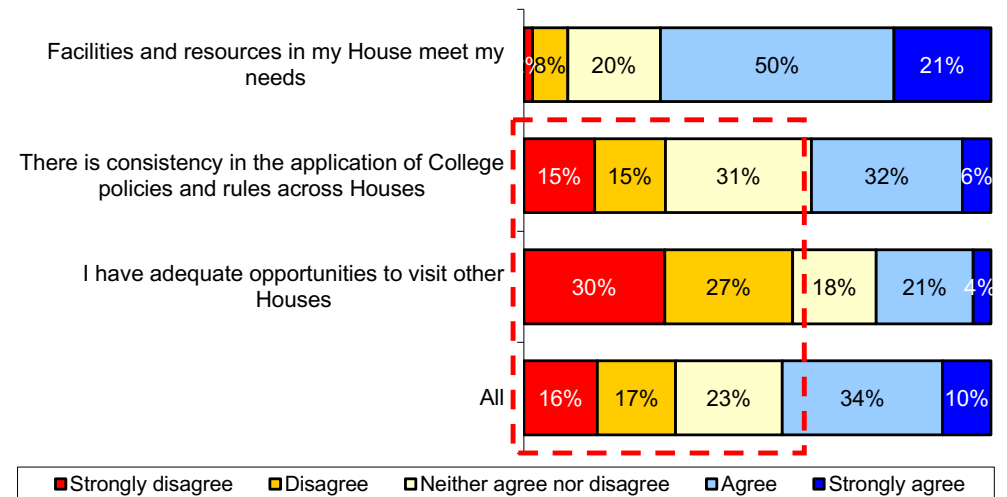

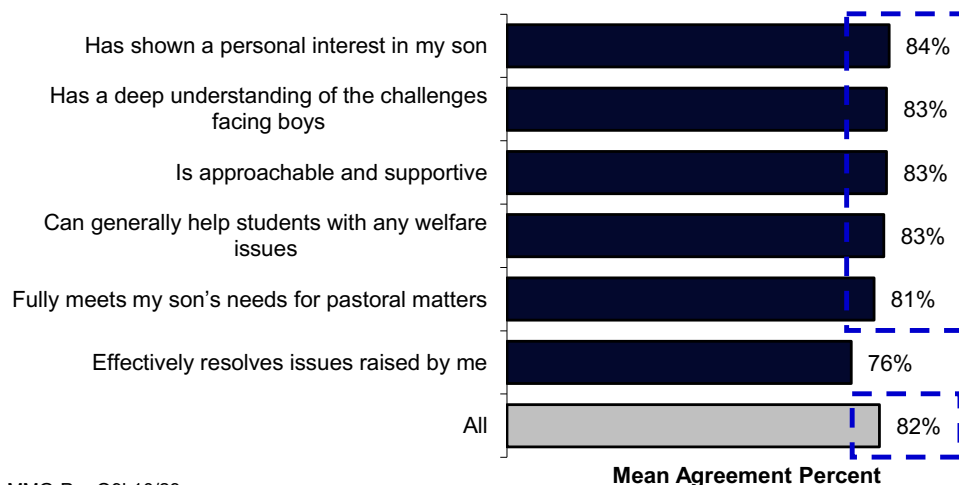

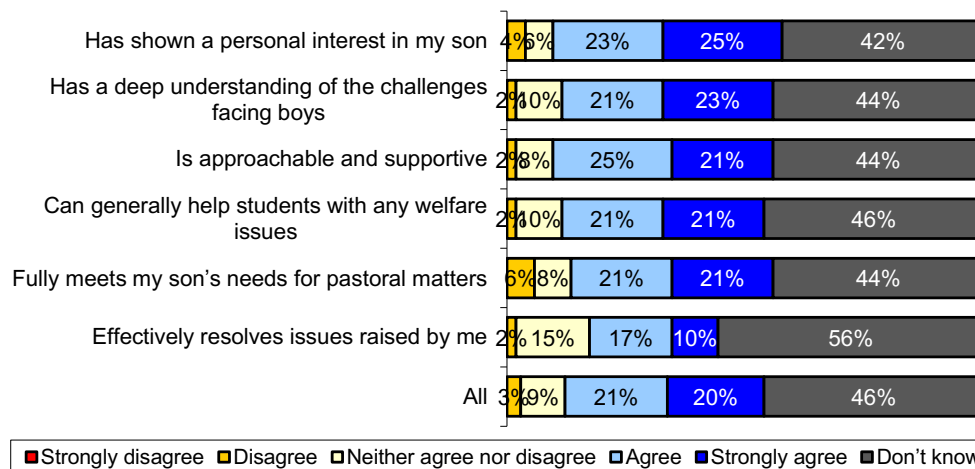

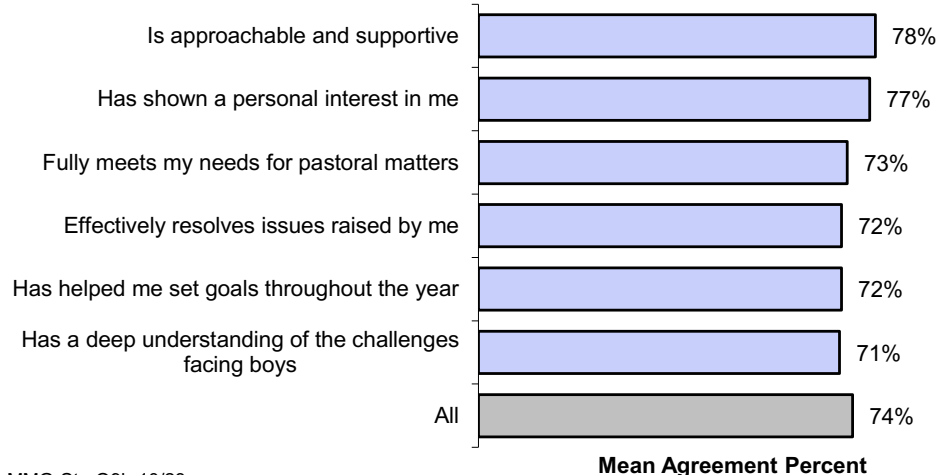

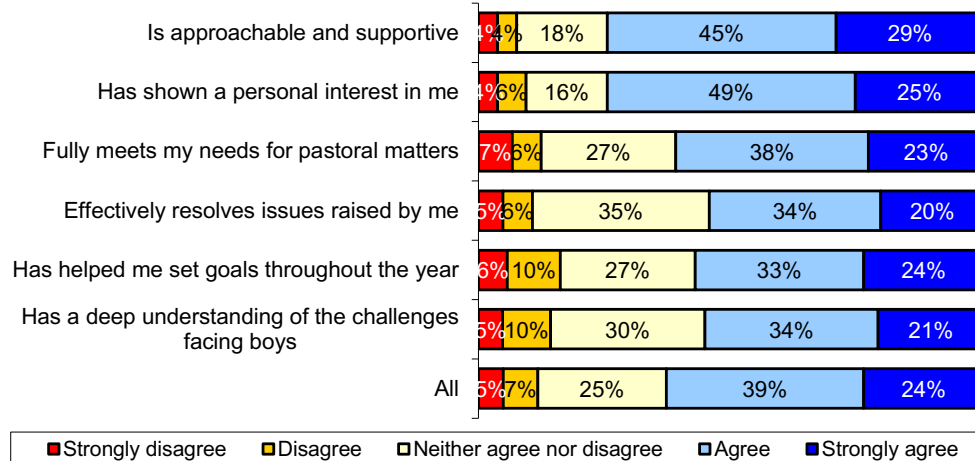

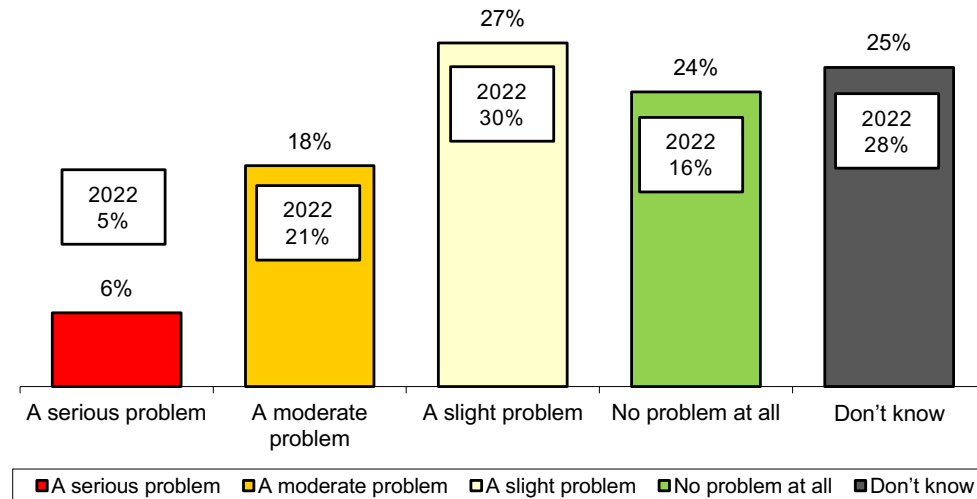

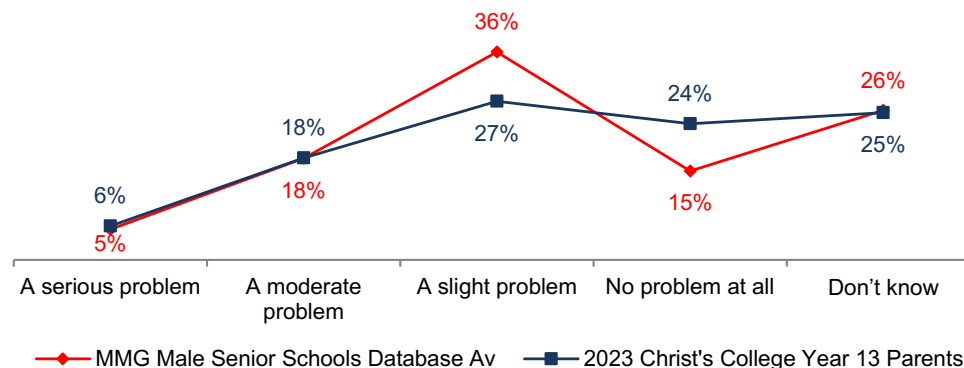

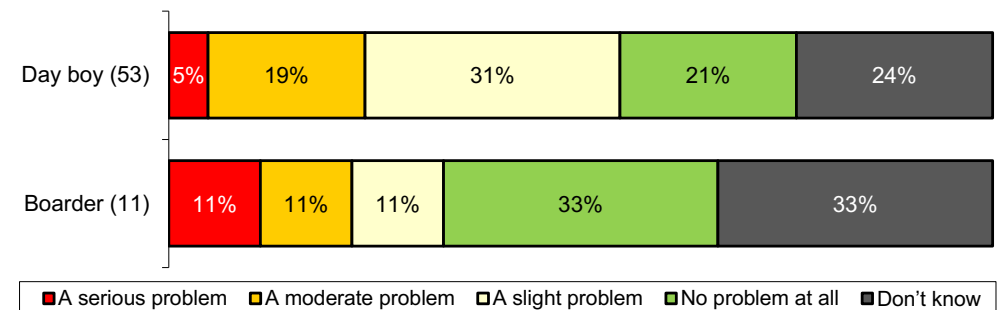

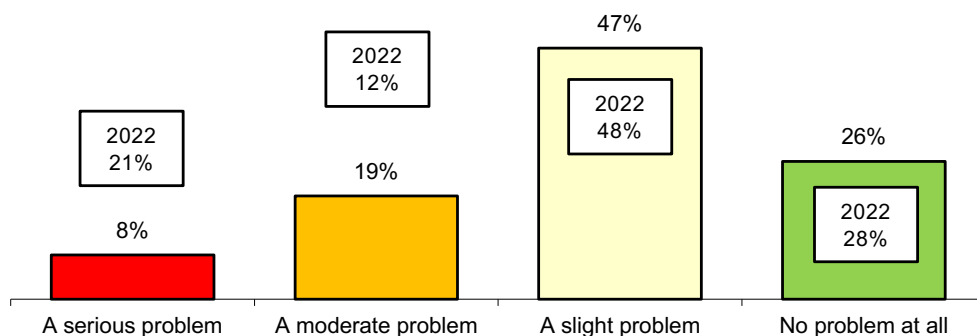

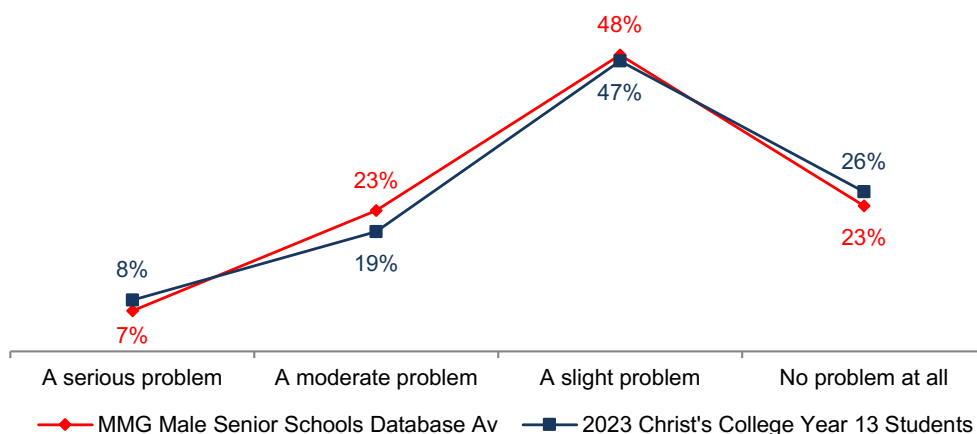

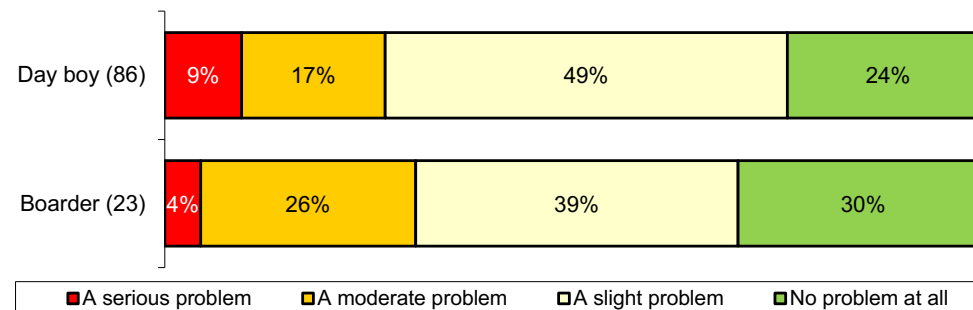

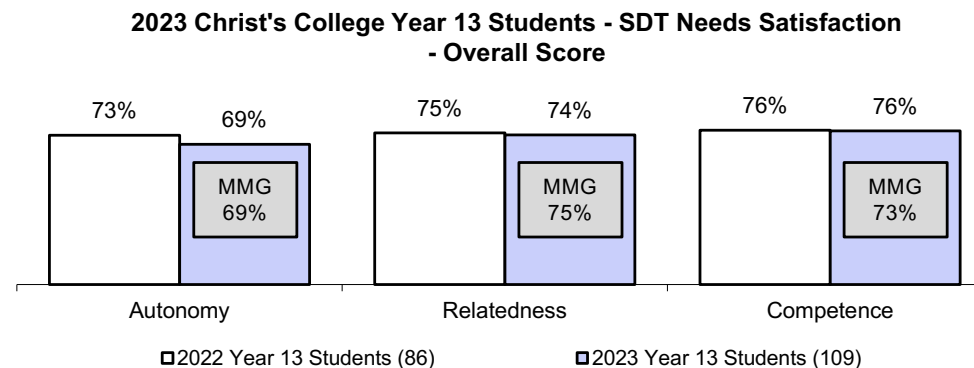
# Self Determination Theory (SDT)

## - Strategies for Improving Wellbeing

The previous section reported how College students scored across the 7 key Wellbeing Domains and demonstrated how student evaluations of the School environment can drive change in these Wellbeing areas.

- Self Determination Theory (SDT) is an empirically derived theory of human motivation, and both psychological and behavioral functioning. It proposes that all people are inherently active and intrinsically motivated on the condition that 3 innate and universal psychological needs are satisfied <sup>1, 2, 3</sup>.
- The 3 Needs are **Autonomy**, **Relatedness** and **Competence**, which are held to be essential for optimal human thriving.
- Satisfaction of these Needs during adolescence has been widely linked with enhanced self-development <sup>2</sup>, intrinsic motivation, **increased mental wellbeing** <sup>4</sup> and optimal identity formation <sup>5</sup>.
- MMG's analysis revealed strong positive relationships ( $r$ ) between students' Needs satisfaction and ALL 6 Wellbeing Domains at College.
- Promoting satisfaction of these 3 needs is one key mechanism that MMG recommends College consider to improve student satisfaction, and therefore fostering improvements in student Wellbeing (as outlined in the previous section).

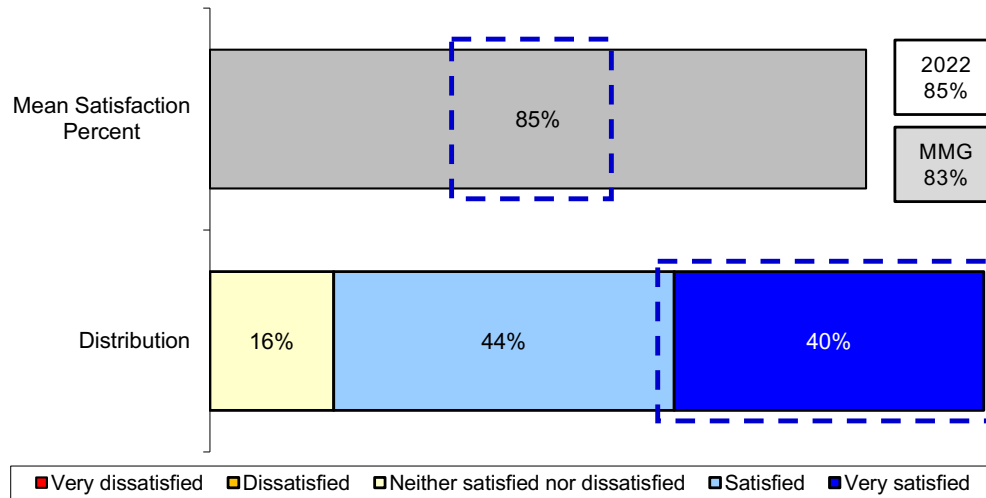
Autonomy, Relatedness and Competence were measured using 9 questions adapted from the **Basic Psychological Needs Satisfaction and Frustration Scale**, a psychometrically validated instrument designed to measure these needs <sup>12</sup>.

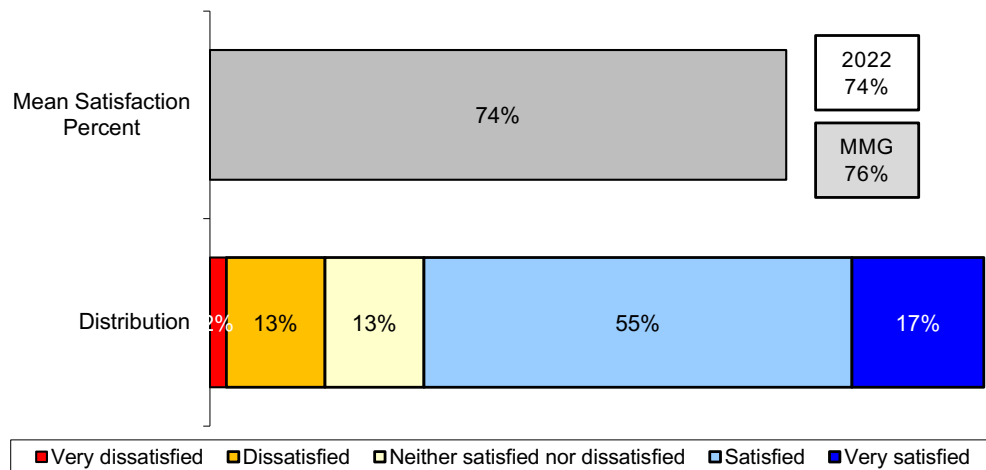

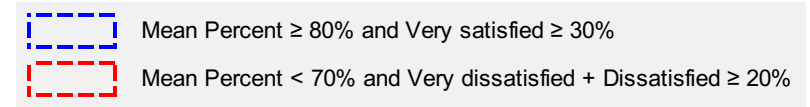

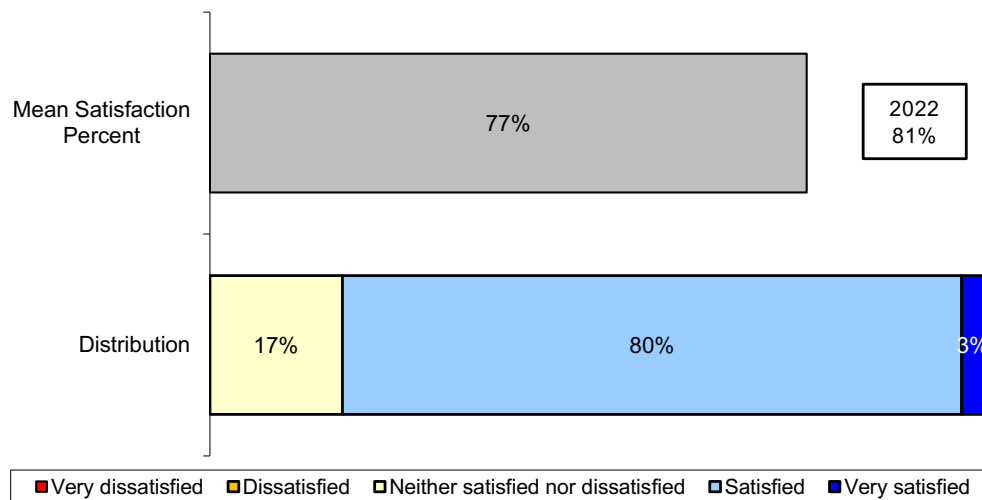

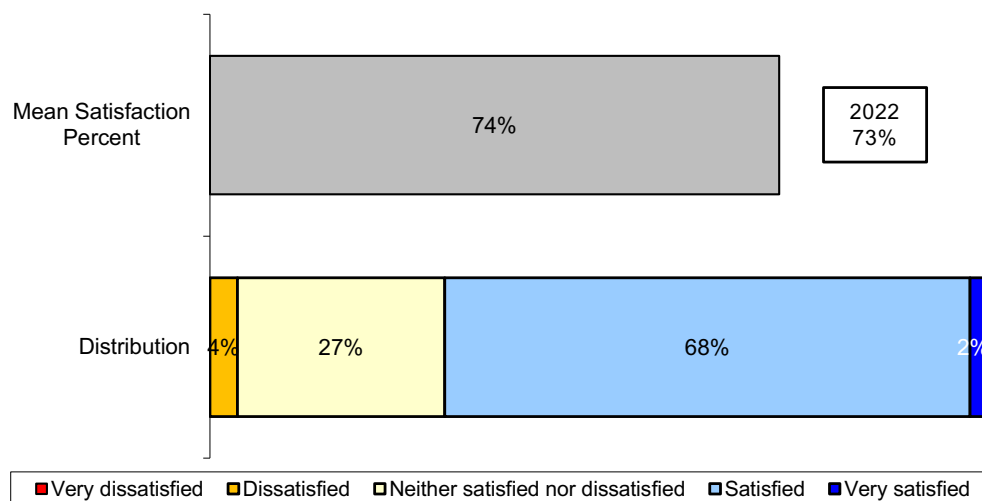

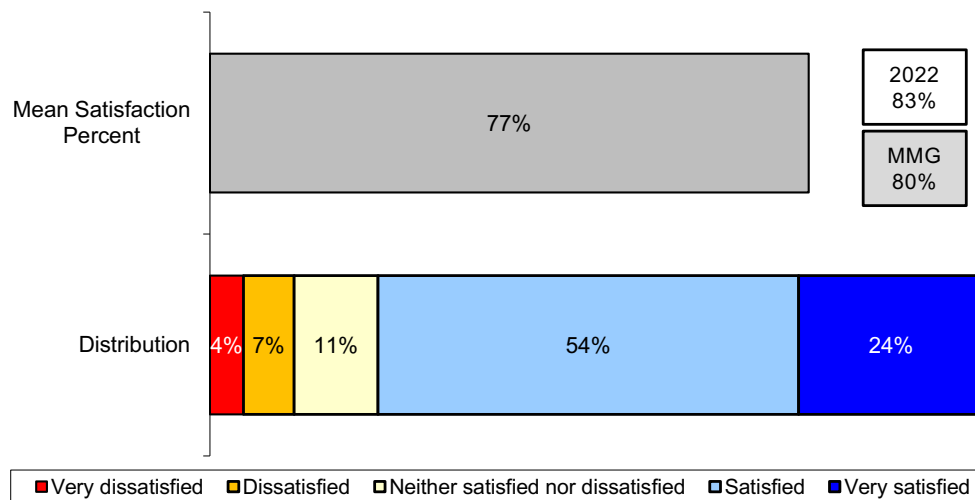

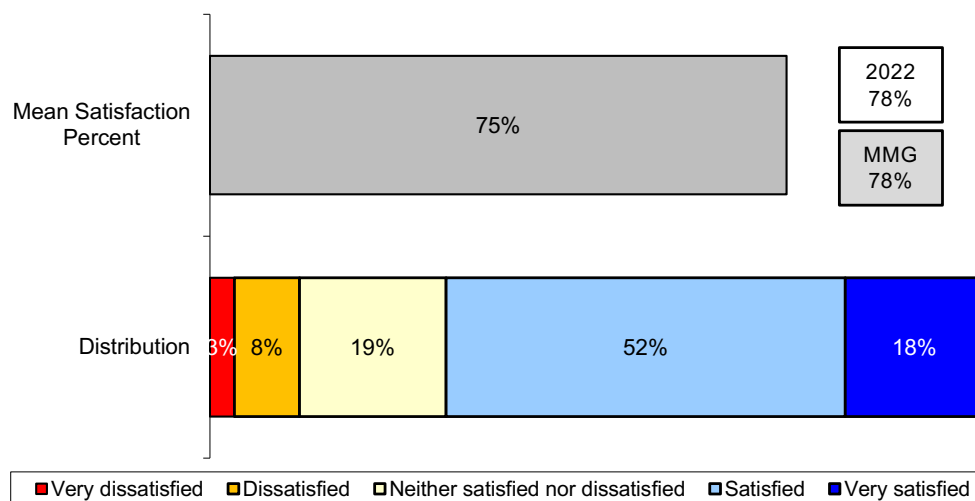

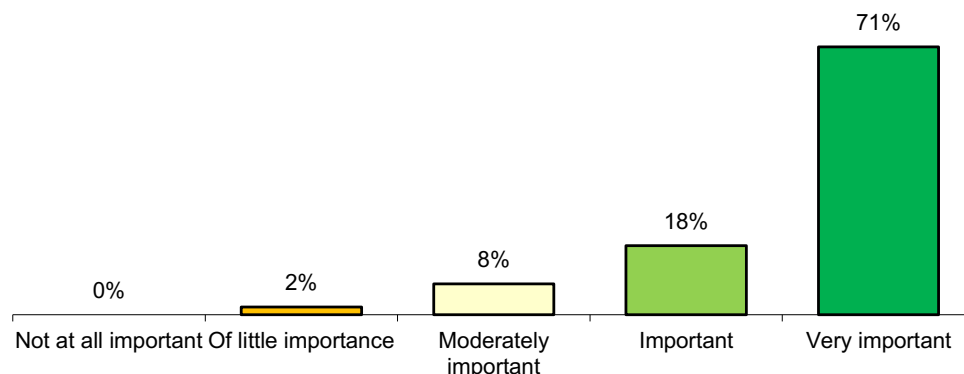

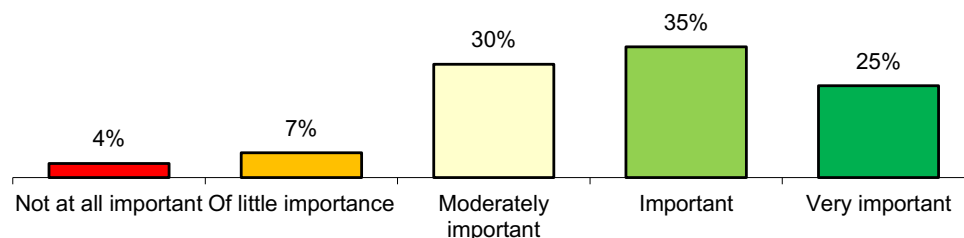


This chart shows students' views on the importance placed of College Houses in the overall welfare of students.

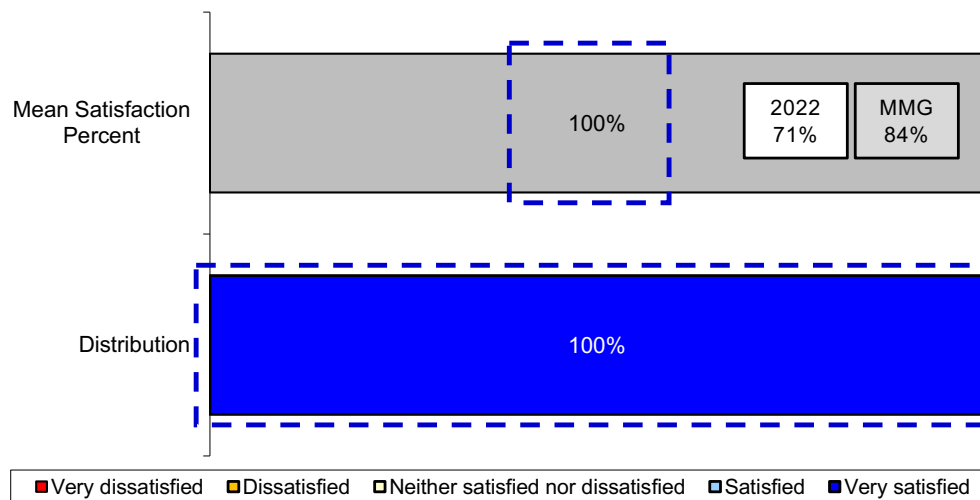

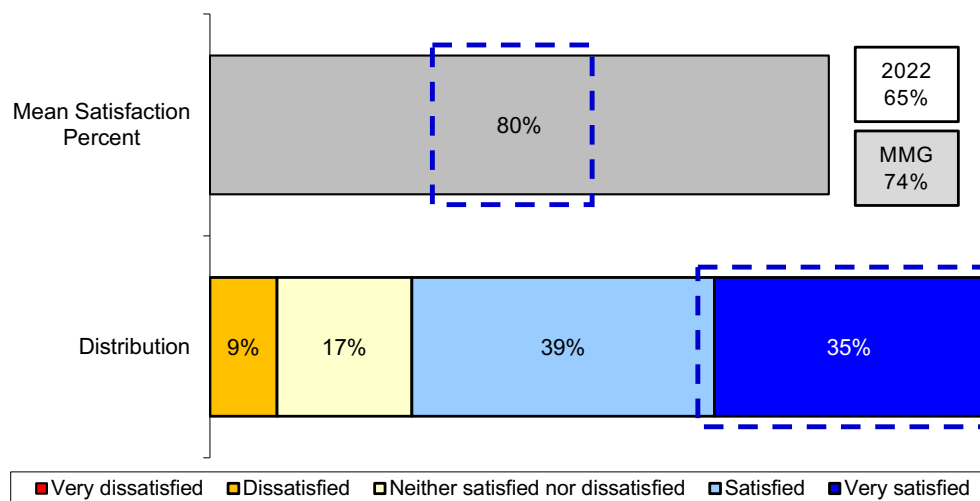

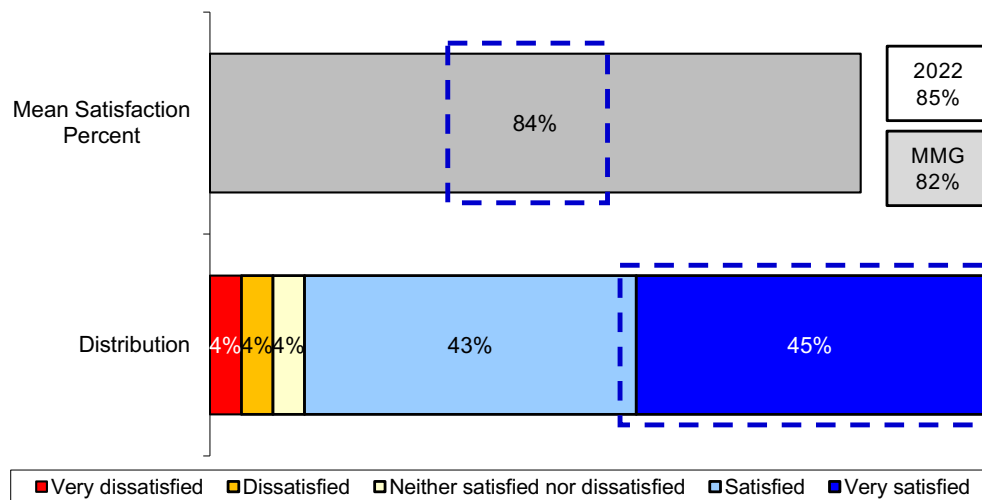

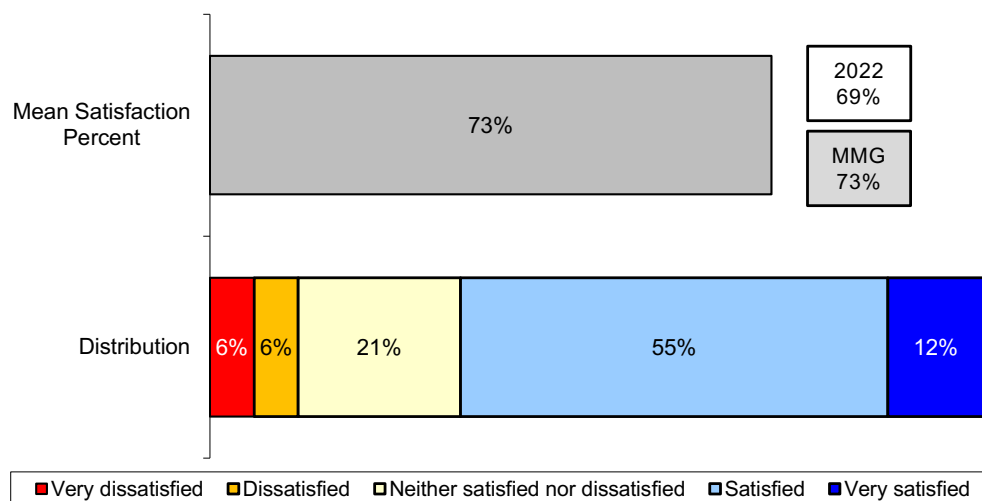

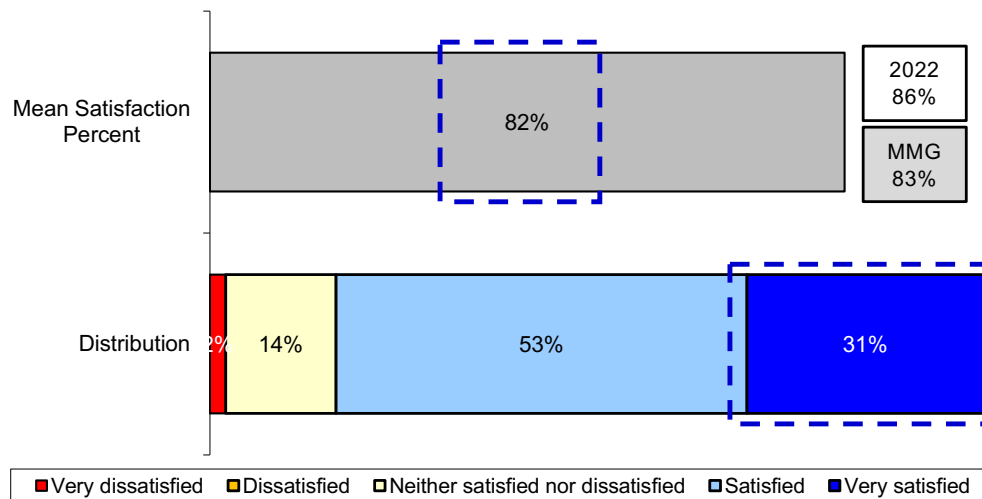

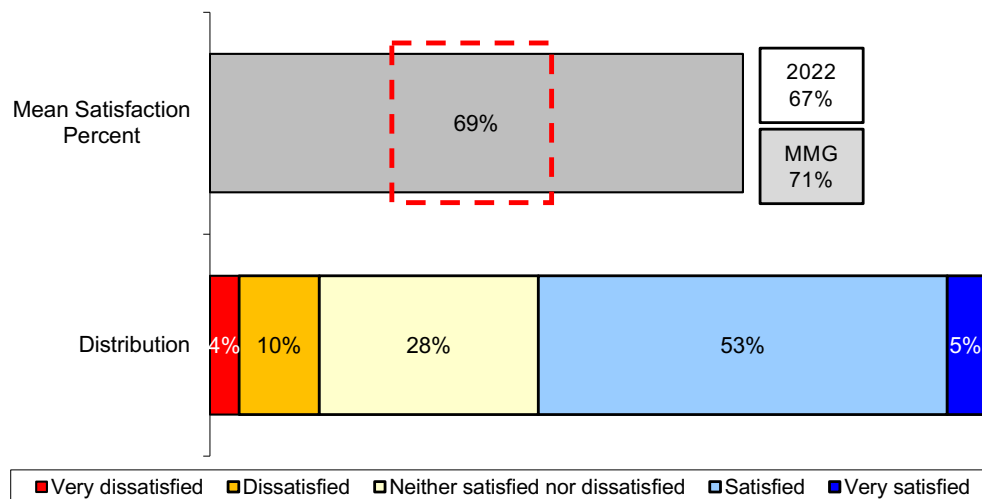

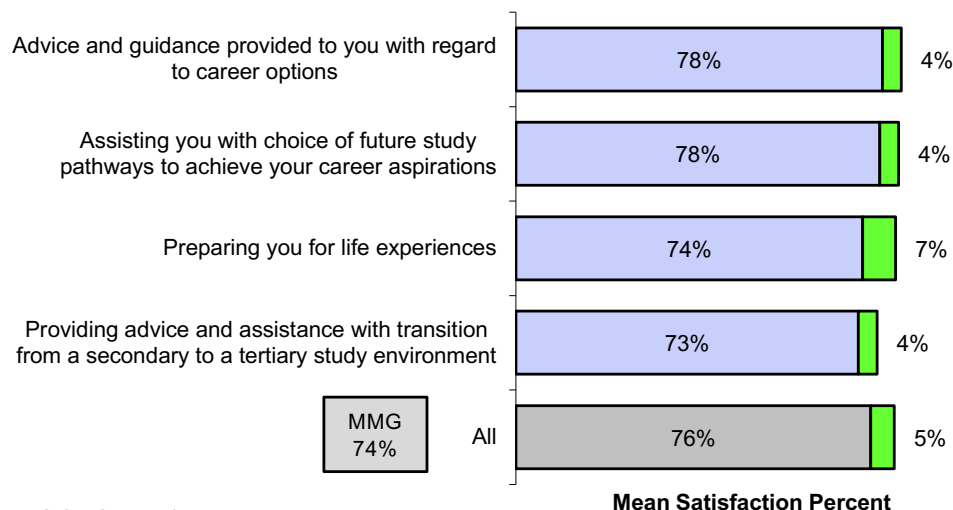

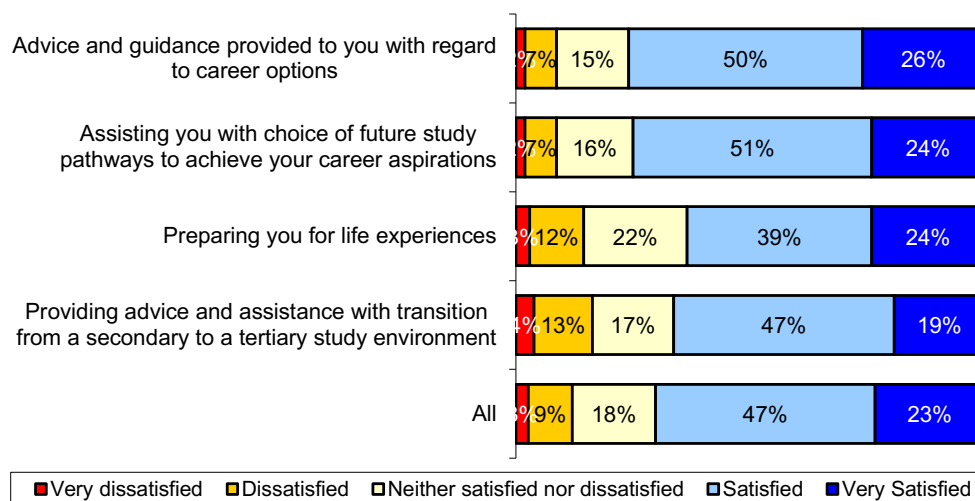

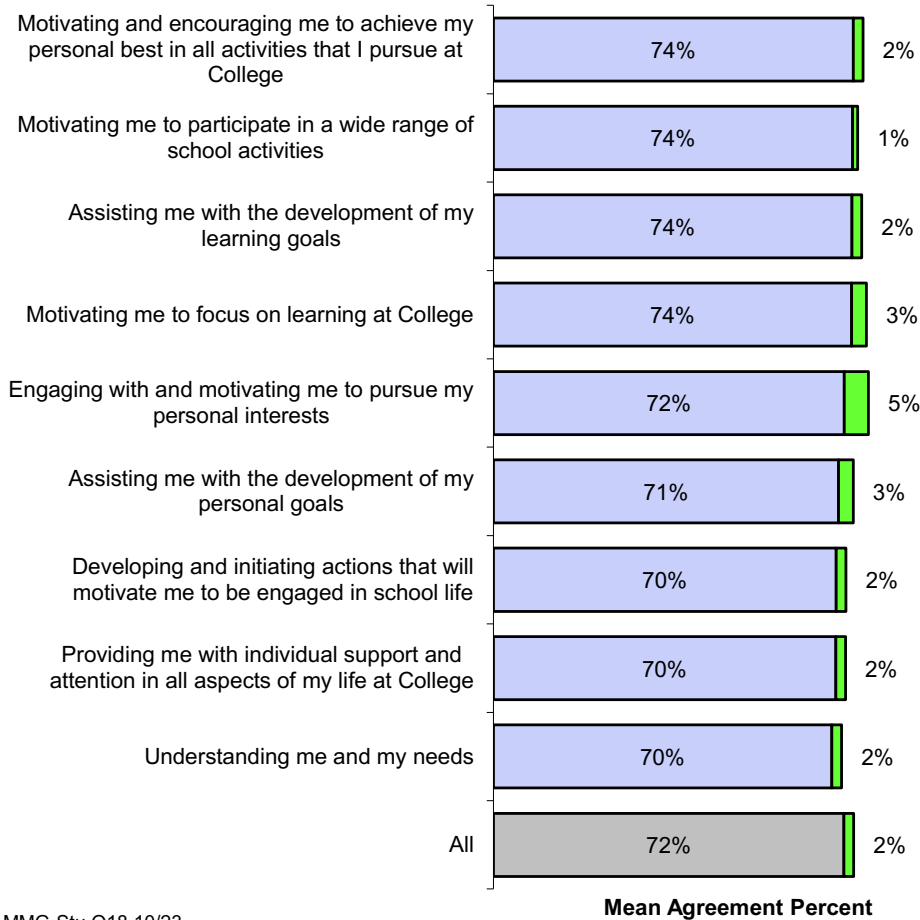

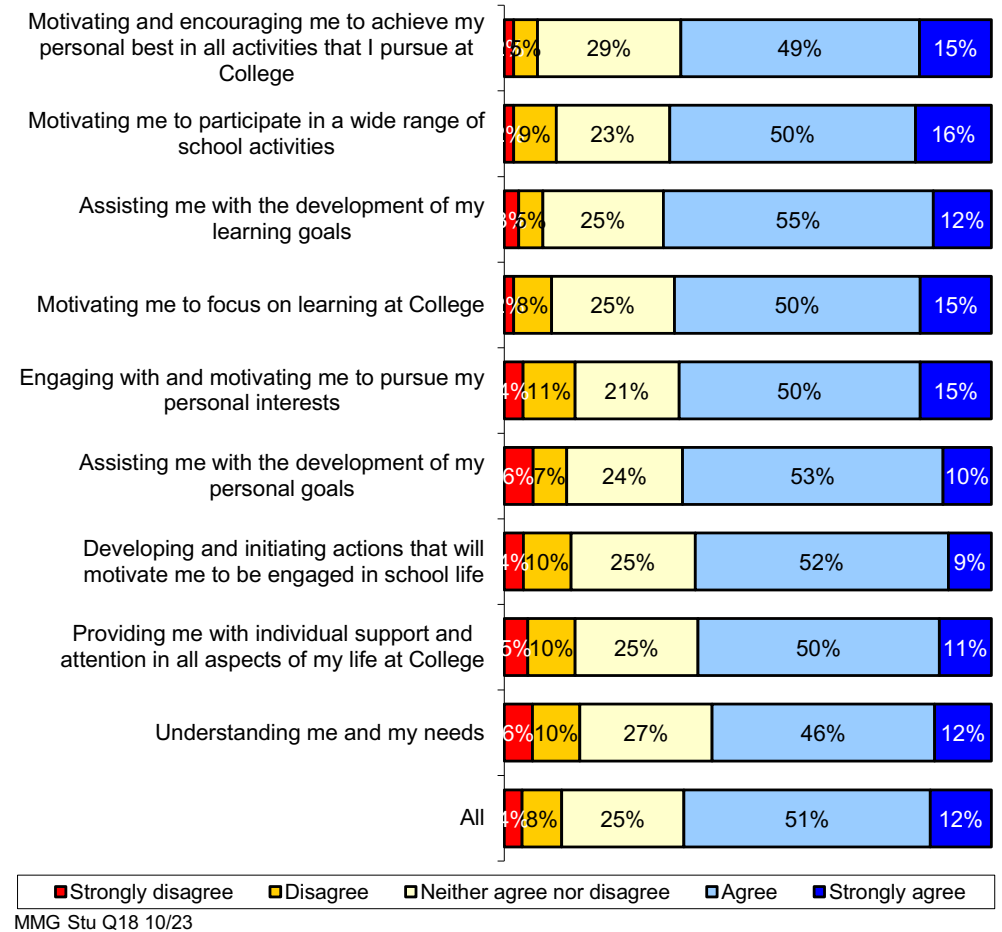

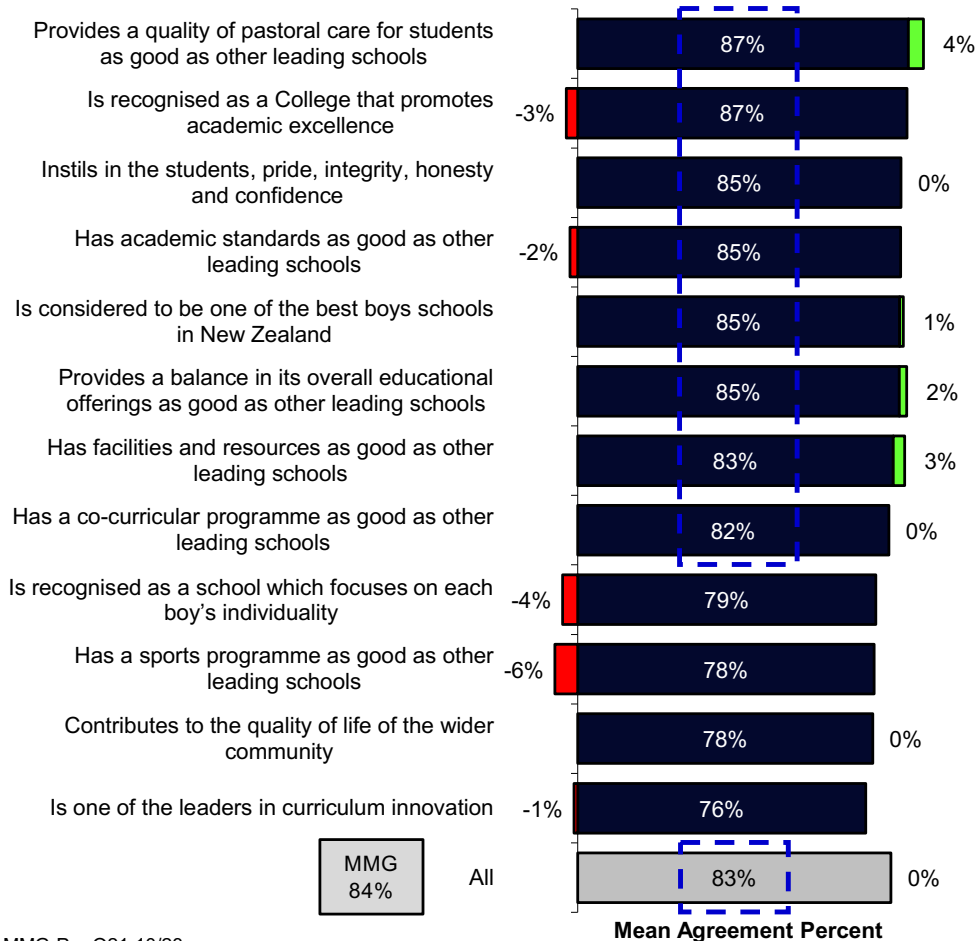

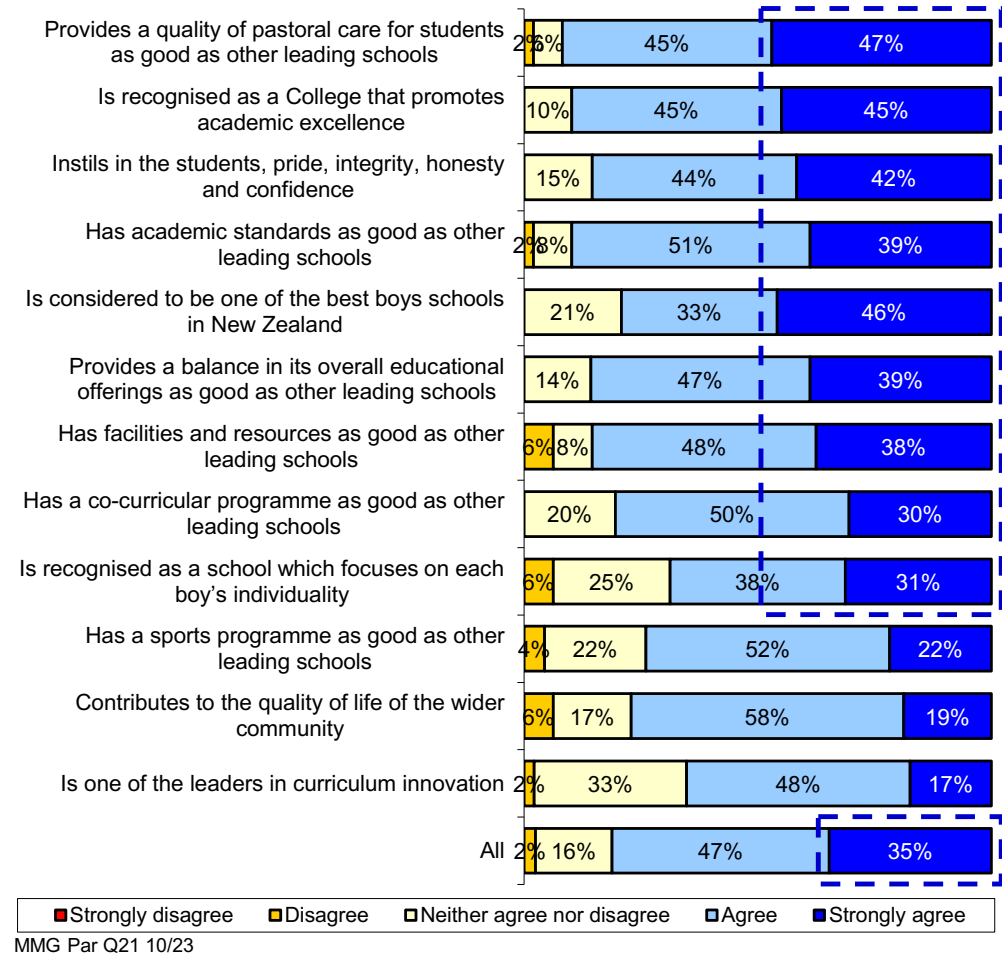

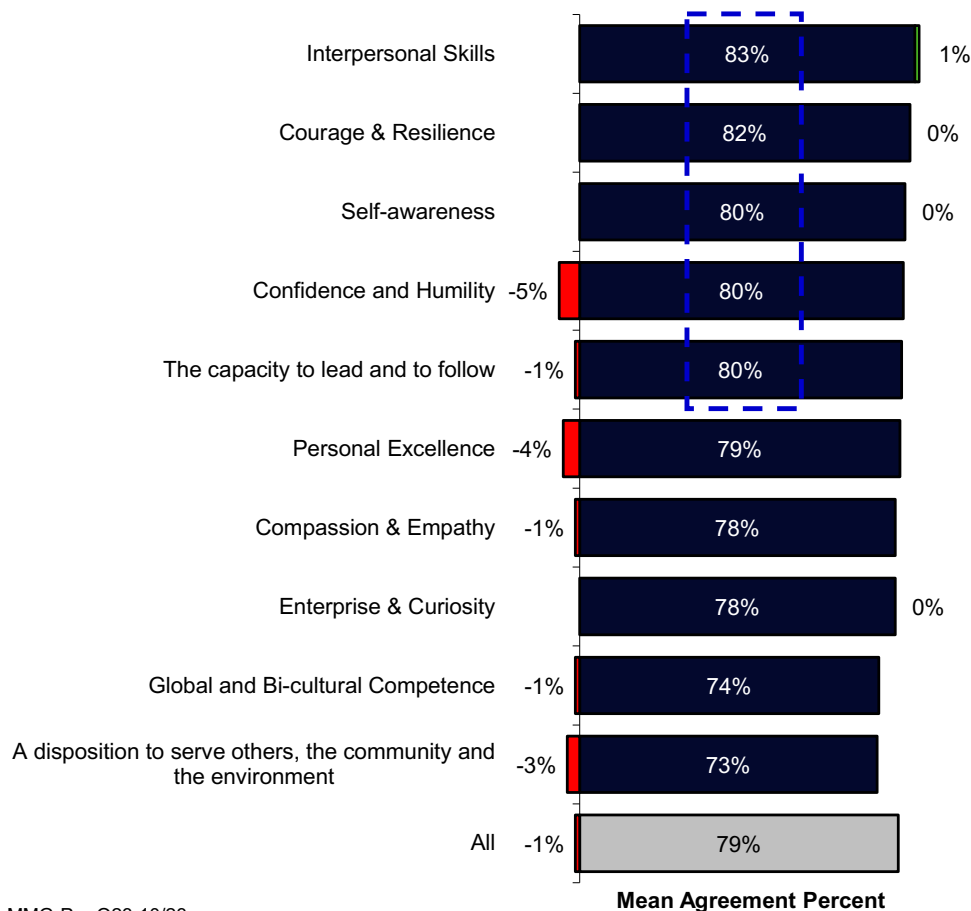

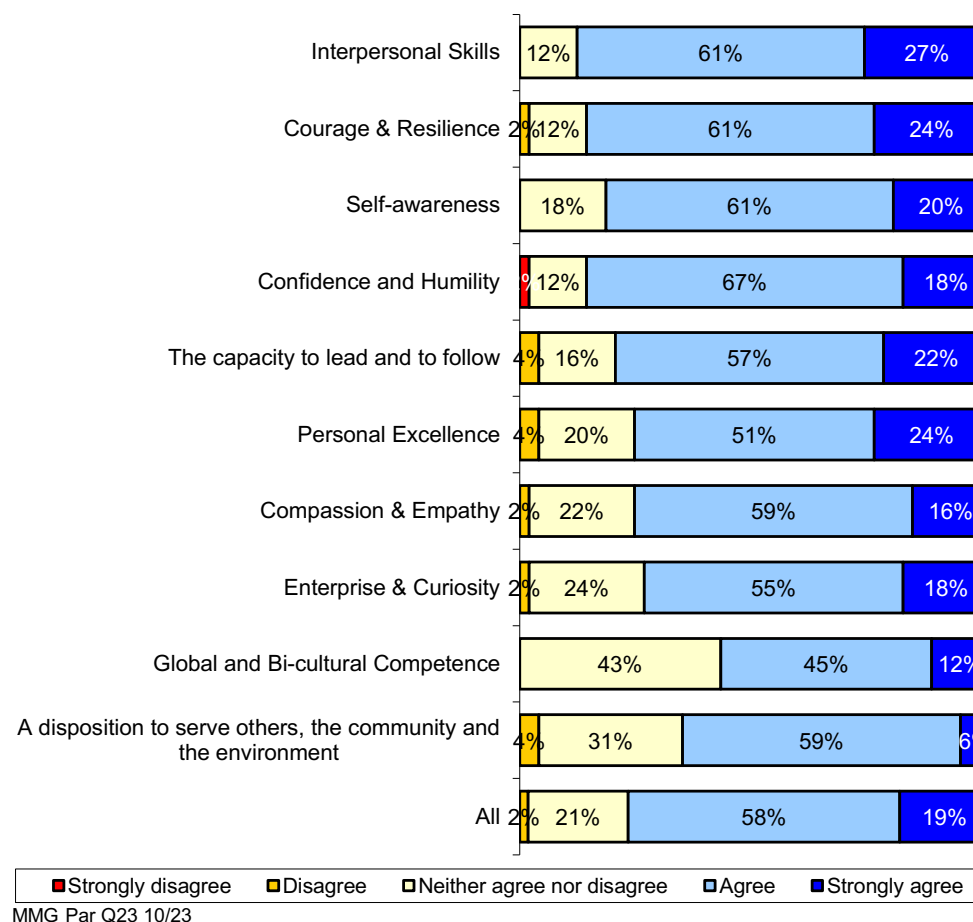

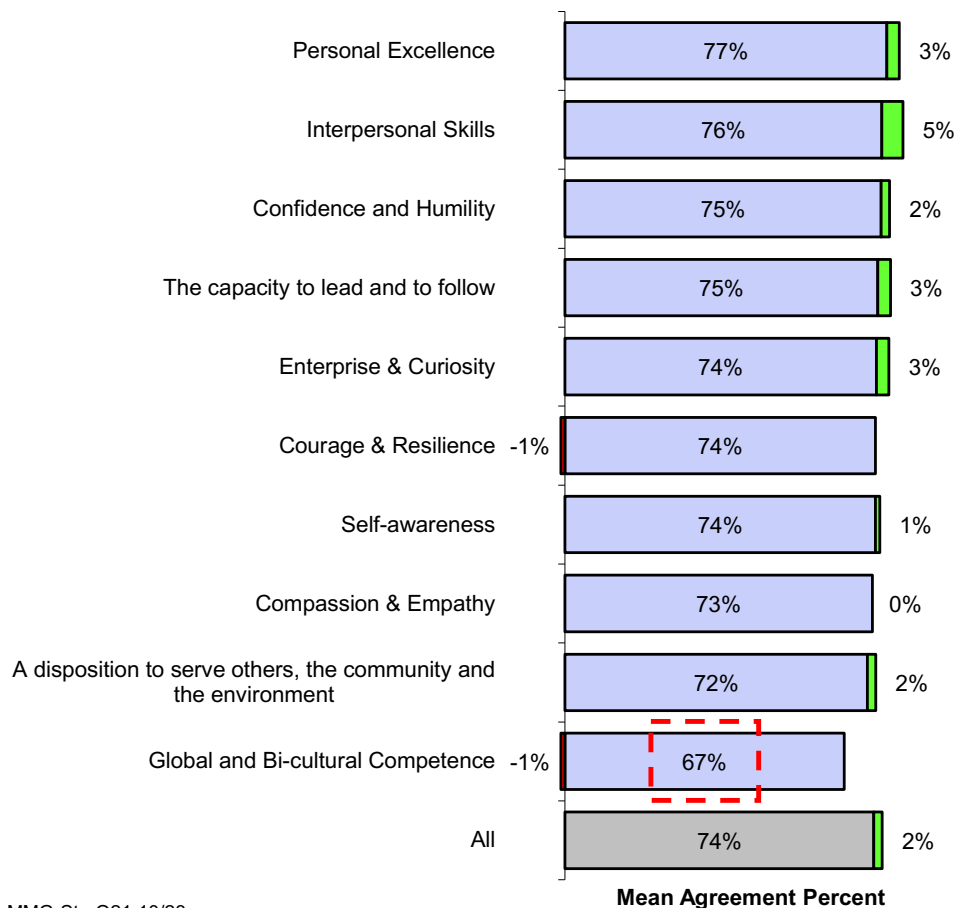
These charts show parents' level of agreement with statements relating to how College has developed their sons' stated characteristics.

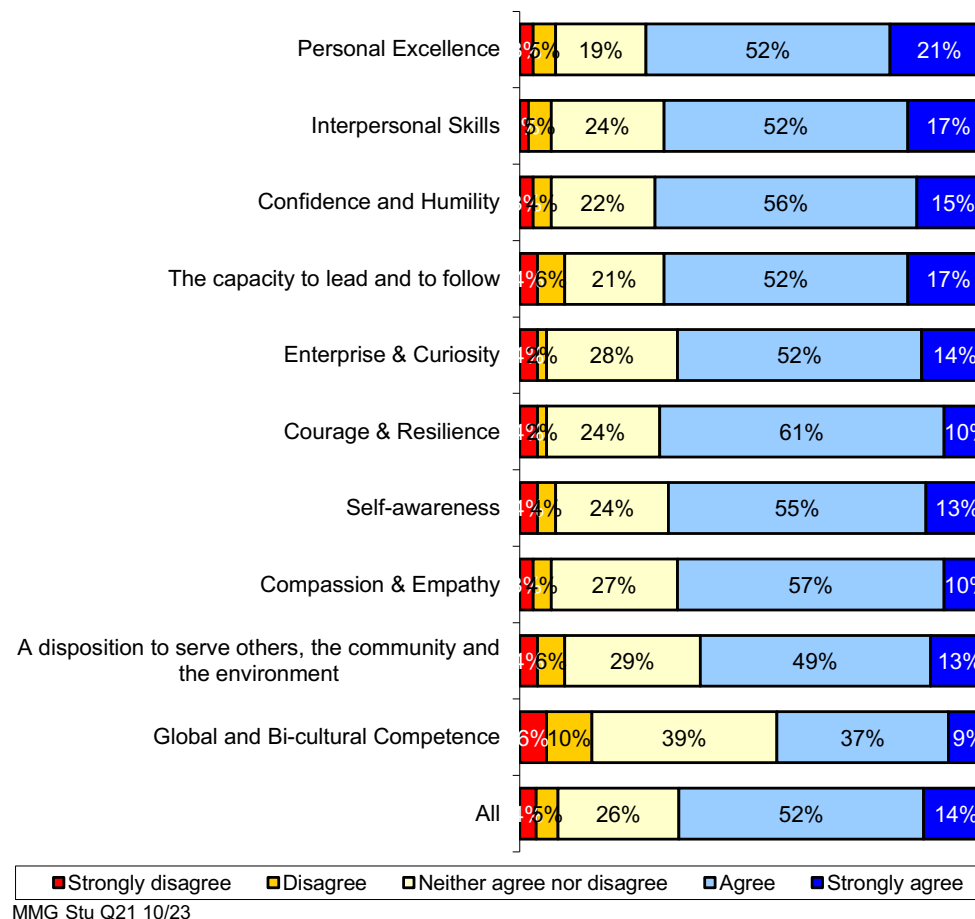
