To be awarded to the student who has shown a Gold level of Academic Engagement and demonstrated a commitment to the ethos of Ngā Miha Mātauranga. The recipient may not be the top academic student, but must have demonstrated a growth mindset to learning and endeavoured to achieve at their best.

## **AK & DF Hancock Prize for the Head Treble**

Legacy of Ruby Elsie Hancock in memory of her sons, Albert Keith Hancock (3652) and Desmond Field Hancock (4164). Both killed in action in World War II.

## **Andrew K Allison Prize for Instrumental Music**

## **Barnett Prizes for Biology, Chemistry, General Science, Mathematics and Physics**

Gift of Sir Louis Barnett in memory of Ralph Fulton Barnett (2306). Killed in action World War I.
