Established in 1996, the family-owned Borthwick Vineyard produces wine with flavours that are a direct reflection of the Gladstone region, New Zealand. Ancient stony, alluvial soils and cool climates allow the grapes to grow in harmony with their environment. Sustainable practices and minimal intervention in the vineyard and winery allow the wines to display distinctive single vineyard characteristics and flavour.

Wine is purchased in case lots. Several varieties may be selected for each case if preferred.

Paddy Borthwick Riesling 2020 \$17.40 per bottle (RRP \$24.00)

An enticing aroma of white florals, lime and savoury apple. Medium bodied, off-dry in style, with intense citrus, lemon-barley and marmalade flavours, showing good depth. Drink now or age for 6 years and let the wine show the developing complexities of a great Riesling.

Paddy Borthwick Pinot Gris 2020 \$17.40 per bottle (RRP \$26.00)

Perfumed aromas of apricots, nectarines and green pears. A rich mid-palate displaying mild oak influence. The wine finishes dry and crisp with lingering hints of warming spice.

Paddy Borthwick Sauvignon Blanc 2020 \$17.40 per bottle (RRP \$25.00)

Aromas of gooseberry, guava, grapefruit and melon, while the palate is balanced by fine acidity and fruit sweetness. A wine with great aromatic power.

Paddy Borthwick Chardonnay 2019 \$18.00 per bottle (RRP \$25.00)

Lifted fruit aromas of nectarines, apricots and pineapple have integrated with fermentation in oak to produce a wine of great texture. Extended yeast contact has lent itself to a creamy palate, with almond and toasted bread aromas. This wine shows depth of fruit and great palate weight that is enjoyable now or cellar for the next 6 years.

Paddy Borthwick Pinot Rosé 2020 \$17.40 per bottle (RRP \$22.00)

Pale pink rosé with delicious cherry, raspberry and watermelon flavours. A totally charming wine made in a dry style with an ethereal texture. Gentle, fruity acidity gives the wine freshness and a lingering finish.

Paddy Borthwick Pinot Noir 2018 \$23.00 per bottle (RRP \$35.00)

Bouquet of maraschino cherries, plums, cranberries and cedar. A core of dark cherry, cloves and wild herbs are supported by bright fruit and French oak that complement a rich soft palate with finely integrated fruit tannins.
