The CCOBA is delighted to continue the tradition of offering a scholarship for 2018.

The Old Boys' Association Scholarship is a 33% reduction of tuition fees – for the academic year commencing in 2018 will be awarded based on the following:

- The scholarship is awarded by the committee on the recommendation of the Executive Principal
- The scholarship is awarded for the entirety of a boy's time at College but subject to satisfactory performance, with the Executive Principal able to recommend withdrawal of the scholarship to the committee
- The criteria for awarding the Scholarship is that it be awarded to a new entrant (preferably, but not necessarily, the descendant of an Old Boy) who would not otherwise have been able to attend College for financial reasons but who would benefit from being educated at College due to his academic attributes and character.
