

Drama Scholarship Guidelines

Christ's College is renowned for the strength of its drama department and offers students many wonderful opportunities to take part in a range of productions. If you wish to apply for a Drama Scholarship for 2018 your application needs to be received by 12 May 2017. Successful applicants will be asked to attend the drama workshop on Friday 9 June.

The audition process is designed to gauge levels of aspiration and disposition for drama processes and performances, with special reference to:

- Controlled spontaneity
- Collaborative empathy for and within the group
- Vocal, physical, spatial awareness and dexterity
- A passion for drama processes and performance

Auditions will take place in two parts.

PART 1 - A five-minute individual session in which each will be invited to:

- Present a prepared script of no more than 90 seconds
- Answer questions about his curriculum vitae in a short conversation

PART 2 - A forty-minute group workshop (with 7–9 other boys) in which all the boys will be invited to participate in and contribute to:

- A warm-up ice breaker
- A physical creativity exercise
- A presentation of a character or relationship scene with another candidate

Note: We ask all participants to wear comfortable clothing and trainers. If you do not want to present a prepared script (Part 1), we will extend the conversation.
